a. <u>Action Reported:</u>								
a) <u>By Field</u>								
<p>1. The publication of Ukrainian newspapers in Germany is continued. The publication of the English language magazine for distribution in the Middle East is in progress through the Field facilities in Germany. This publication will be distributed from Germany by utilizing the contacts, the addresses, and the recommendations acquired by Prolog Associates in New York and Washington with the representatives of the Afro-Asian countries in U.S. Embassies and in the UNO. The magazine in its first issue will offer several articles written by Prolog Associates on the subject of the Soviet internal colonialism and treatment of nationalities in the USSR.</p>								
b) <u>By Headquarters</u>								
<p>1. The production of radio scripts for daily broadcasts through PYREX is continued and the scripts prepared by Prolog Associates reflect the current events and their implication for the Ukrainian nationals.</p> <p>2. Public meetings are taking place according to schedule in all major cities of the United States and Canada at which the sufferings of the Ukrainians in the Soviet concentration camps are exposed. Each meeting results in a resolution submitted to the UNO.</p> <p>3. The Ukrainian broadcasts from Radio Nacional (Madrid) are directed and guided by Prolog Associates in New York who are supplying them with the appropriate material for the broadcasting. The radio broadcasts from Madrid are following the objectives and the policy of moderate nationalism as it has been established by Prolog Associates through the PYREX broadcasts in Athens.</p> <p>4. Prolog Associates have undertaken to ship to Melbourne Russian books published in the West for the purpose of their distribution to the members of the Soviet Olympic Team in Australia. This distribution will be accomplished through the facilities available to the Ukrainian nationals in Melbourne, with whom Prolog Associates are in contact. The books for the most part represent the uncensored views on Soviet life and realities as expressed by the Russian emigres in the West. It is believed that these books will constitute a considerable interest to the Soviet personnel and a propaganda effect derived from them to serve the objectives of our policy.</p>

5. Contact with the Argentina Ukrainian emigration has been continued for the purpose of up-to-date information on the activities of Soviet repatriation teams in that area. A dispatch has been sent out [] concerning the Ukrainian nationals in Buenos Aires and their potential for collection of information.

6. A proposal has been made by Prolog Associates to institute broadcasts in the Far East which would be prepared by Prolog Associates in New York in the Russian language and which would promote the local interests of the people, as against the centralized power of the Soviet regime in Moscow. The sample of such a broadcast has been submitted for our approval.

7. The sending of packages to relatives in the USSR offers a possibility of using these channels for propaganda. A proposal for this action has been made by Prolog Associates, who can acquire a considerable list of Soviet individual addresses for the purpose of sending them individual letters. The exchange of correspondence between the USSR and the free world at the present time is not undergoing as severe censorship as it was before, and therefore it provides an opportunity for utilizing this channel in propaganda.

8. The liberalization of exchange between the Soviets and the western world offers a possibility of sending to the USSR Ukrainian individuals born in the United States but speaking fluent Ukrainian, in order to reestablish political contact between the former Ukrainian underground and the Ukrainian emigres in the West. A proposal to this effect has been made by Prolog Associates and has been submitted for approval.

9. The Greek Catholic Church of the Western Ukraine has its representatives in Poland, and the Monastic Order of St. Basil opened its branch in Warsaw, Poland. A visit to this branch will be made in the near future by a priest who is a personal friend of AECASSOWARY/2 and who resides in New York City. AECASSOWARY/2 proposed to utilize this opportunity for the purpose of the collection of information. The proposal has been submitted for approval.
