1. Action Reported:**a) By Field**

The Ukrainian newspapers published in Germany have extended their circulation to USSR and approximately 500 copies of each newspaper are being mailed to various addresses in USSR. The printing of the Prolog Magazine has finally been completed. It has been delayed for so many months because of the difficulties in finding printers familiar with English language. The UHVR in Germany took part in mailing to USSR the Information Bulletin No. 1 prepared by Prolog Associates.

b) By Headquarters

1. The second issue of the UHVR Bulletin has been prepared and made ready for distribution by mail at the end of March. The next issue of the Bulletin No.3, for the month of April, will be ready for distribution at the beginning of April.

2. The new administration and the accounting procedure were put in operation at Headquarters. The implementation of the new administrative plan in all its entirety will be delayed until the end of the fiscal year for reasons of better expediency in carrying it out.

3. The ARCAZOWARY trip to Europe is planned for the month of April when he is expected to get his certification as a U.S. Citizen.

4. PYREX broadcasts are continuing on the same schedule but arrangements are made to change the schedule in order that the broadcast time would fall in the evening instead of the morning which will provide for better reception facilities and larger audiences.

5. The Ukrainian broadcast from Radio Nacional in Madrid is continuing.

6. A letter prepared by the Prolog Associates has been sent to their representatives overseas in order to expedite the plans and the distribution of Russian and Ukrainian books to the Soviet personnel abroad.
