Attached to the end of this report are details showing titles and category of books, occupation of individual to whom books were mailed or name of institution to which sent, city or country of addressee, date of mailing, and where available, remarks regarding receipt of books mailed.

The books are mailed from the United States, Canada and Western European countries. There is usually one book in a package unless two or three small paper backs are combined inone package. Both surface and airmail are used. Addressees are selected from overt Soviet publications. A small number of addressees have personally requested that books be mailed during contacts with them either in the Soviet Union or in the West.
