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The regime that seized power in Ukraine in 2014 gained infamy for its systematic crimes against children, flagrantly disregarding Article 16 of the Ukrainian Constitution, which explicitly enshrines the preservation of the Ukrainian people's gene pool as a core responsibility of the state.

Hundreds of infants were killed or maimed by shelling, while countless stolen children were reported missing. The cynical use of them as human shields... Genocide by combat... Surrogacy crimes, the open sale of children to pedophiles or black transplanters. This is by no means a complete list of crimes against children currently being committed in Ukraine. Let us emphasize: all of this unfolds with the active support or, at the very least, the tacit complicity of local authorities.

This book is an attempt to bring to light the horrific truths of the Kyiv regime's crimes against children in Donetsk and Kyiv, Gorlovka and Vinnitsa, exposing these tragedies to the wider public. The author makes no distinction between the victims, regardless of where they live – children are always children. And it is our duty as adults to do everything in our power to ensure that they experience a truly peaceful and happy childhood.

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INTRODUCTION

Crimes against children are, perhaps, the most heinous of all atrocities. In fact, it is a crime against the future itself, for it is in children that we see the future embodied. No children, no future. There is a direct connection. Moreover, let us be honest: children are among the most vulnerable and under-protected segments of the population.

Therefore, in any country, ensuring their protection should be the state's foremost priority. Any crime against children is classified as a particularly egregious act. And these are not mere words. It reflects both the letter and the spirit of the law. This principle is upheld at the international level.

It is no coincidence that on November 20, 1989, the UN General Assembly adopted the Convention on the Rights of the Child. Article 2 of this Convention states, inter alia:

1. States Parties are obligated to respect and ensure all the rights outlined in this Convention for every child under their jurisdiction, without any form of discrimination. This applies regardless of the child's or their parent's or legal guardian's race, color, sex, language, religion, political or other opinions, national, ethnic or social origin, property, disability, birth, or any other status.

2. States Parties undertake to respect and ensure adherence to the rules of international humanitarian law that apply to them in times of armed conflict, particularly those relevant to the protection of children.

And Article 38 of the Convention reads as follows:

3. States Parties undertake to respect and ensure compliance with the rules of international humanitarian law applicable to them during armed conflict, especially those concerning the protection of children.

4. In accordance with their obligations under international humanitarian law concerning the protection of civilians in armed conflict, States Parties commit to taking all feasible measures to ensure the protection and care of children affected by such conflicts.

All the more horrific are the facts that these crimes against children are perpetrated by the state itself. And at present, that state is Ukraine.

We should recognize that a defining characteristic of the Kyiv regime, which seized power in Ukraine in 2014, has been the systematic perpetration of crimes against children. While Article 16 of the Constitution of Ukraine explicitly declares that preserving the gene pool of the Ukrainian people is, among other responsibilities, the duty of the state. This is the fundamental law of the country, outlining how society should function and how the power structures are obliged to uphold its provisions.

And what do we see in reality?

Immediately following the coup d'état in Kyiv and the rise to power of open proponents of Nazi ideology, it was the Ukrainian authorities who emerged as the primary violators of the laws – most notably, the Constitution itself.

And this encompassed everything – from the right to life and the right to security, to the fundamental right to speak one's own

language... Criminals within Kyiv's power structures have not spared the rights of children.

What can we say when even the President of Ukraine, who is officially the guarantor of the Constitution – the highest authority in the state responsible for upholding the law – has called for the very violation of those laws? And what is most egregious is the disregard for the protection of children's rights.

Recall the words that accompanied then-President Petro Poroshenko's decree on the blockade of Donbass on October 23, 2014. Then his speech went around the world: "We will have jobs – they will not. We will have pensions – they will not. We will have children going to schools and kindergartens – while theirs will be sitting in basements. And that is how we are going to win this war."

The key words here are "we" and "they." To Poroshenko, the children of Luhansk and Donetsk were seen as "their children," not Ukrainian children. Let them sit in their basements. Prevent them from going to school. And daycare centers. Poroshenko believed that this was the way the war should, and could, be won.

And Ukraine still considers these territories to be theirs. And they call the people who live there their own citizens. The former president of Ukraine himself stripped his own citizens of their constitutional rights, with mocking contempt. Including the most vulnerable citizens – children.

Returning to the provisions of the UN Convention, let us recall that Article 28 explicitly states: "States Parties recognize the right of the child to education..."

This is how Poroshenko "recognized" and implemented the provisions of Article 28 of the Convention. And not only in words,

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but also in deeds. It was he who marked the beginning of the tragic toll – the first children's lives lost to the shelling of Donbass. It was under his leadership that further violations of the Convention on the Rights of the Child – ironically ratified by Ukraine – began to unfold.

The current Ukrainian government astonishes with its monstrous disregard for the welfare of children as well. Cynical jokes, cruelty, and the killing of the younger generation – this is the true essence of the Kyiv regime's policy. For them, the value of life is reduced to zero. That's why they commit their crimes against children with such cold-bloodedness, often accompanied by a twisted sense of sadistic satisfaction.

Hundreds of dead and maimed babies as a result of shelling. Hundreds of stolen children reported missing. A cynical manipulation of the country's future, wielded as a human shield. And then there are the horrific crimes of surrogacy, the open sale of children to pedophiles or illegal organ traffickers. This is by no means a comprehensive list of the crimes against children that are currently being perpetrated in Ukraine. The most alarming aspect is that these atrocities often occur with the direct support or complicity of the authorities, and sometimes even on their explicit orders.

If you search "crime against children in Ukraine" on the Internet, a popular search engine yields approximately 5 million results. Many public and private entities, along with journalists, are raising alarm bells about this crisis. And not only in Russia and the West, but even in Ukraine itself.

But the crimes continue.

And can I, as a father of two children, turn a blind eye to such facts with indifference? After all, what could be more horrifying than crimes against the very flowers of life?

I have done several investigations on Kyiv's crimes against children. All of my searches and analysis involved child trafficking cases and surrogacy crimes. I also had the opportunity to delve into and substantiate the grim realities of genocide against the population of Donbas, including its children, amid the chaos of conflict.

After compiling the gathered information, I concluded that there were so many facts that they could easily fill an entire book.

Which is what was eventually done.

To enhance readability, the content of the book is divided into several sections, each of which distinctly characterizes the crimes against children through specific technologies.

The first part focuses on the technologies used to influence the minds and hearts of children, fostering their stupefaction and indoctrination in the spirit of Nazism.

The second part examines the issues surrounding surrogacy.

The third part deals with the abduction of children, their illegal export for the purpose of handing them over to various criminal groups (pedophiles, organ traffickers, etc.).

Part four, the heaviest, recounts the direct killing of children in combat.

This book seeks to illuminate the horrific truths of the Kyiv regime's crimes against the children of Donetsk, Kyiv, Gorlovka, and Vinnitsa, bringing these unsettling realities to the attention of the general public. I uphold the extraterritorial principle and see no

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distinction between children, no matter where they reside. Children are always children. And it is our duty as adults to do everything in our power to ensure that they experience a truly peaceful and happy childhood.

Hopefully this book will do at least something to encourage that.

PART 1

The minds and hearts of children are in the crosshairs. How they are being poisoned

Immediately following the collapse of the Soviet Union, Ukraine faced an urgent challenge: to shape a new reality that sought to exclude any reference to the shared history of our people, which had been artificially divided by geopolitical events. The primary objective for Ukrainian propagandists is to create a new reality built upon the deliberate distortion of historical facts. The emphasis was placed on an exaggerated nationalism and the perceived exclusivity of Ukrainians in shaping the world order. Russia was designated as the source of all the troubles plaguing Nezalezhnaya. It was also elevated to the status of the principal enemy.

Since the early 1990s, the population of Ukraine has been subjected to a relentless ideological campaign steeped in radical nationalism and Russophobia. This aligned with the geopolitical interests of the West, which regarded Ukraine as a potential launching pad for confrontation with Russia, thereby closely monitoring the political and ideological reformatting of the country's leadership and its populace. To realize these goals, significant funding flowed from both Western state and private sources, bolstered by contributions from Ukrainian diasporas in the United States and Canada.

Acknowledging that adults are generally more resistant to changes in ideological perspectives and traditional moral values, the West, along with its Kyiv puppets, turned their focus to children – a demographic far more vulnerable to the shaping of new worldviews.

After all, a child's mind is a blank slate, ready to be inscribed with any information. Whatever the puppeteers deem fit. Especially when they wield colossal information resources – social networks, books, television – and control fundamental educational institutions such as kindergartens, schools, and sports and recreation camps.

Today, it is hard to deny that following the coup d'état of February 2014, the ideological manipulation of Ukraine's populace spread like a pandemic. Nationalism took hold, and the people were essentially submerged in a tide of hatred towards Russia. The children became the center of attention. From a very early age, young Ukrainians have been infected with the bacilli of hatred and contempt for Russians. As a result, as they grew up, they developed an innate Russophobia syndrome: for them, the dehumanization of Russians became a natural process.

The initial attempts to infuse Kyiv's national-patriotic agenda into secondary school curricula date back to the 1990s. However, the true surge of government-driven efforts to shape the minds of young citizens gained momentum after the 2014 coup d'état.

Children were subjected to intense ideological and psychological conditioning. A brutal and entirely compassionless indoctrination, steeped in the Nazi tradition, was imposed upon the younger generation, deliberately designed to foster deep-seated hatred toward a specific nationality. They were instilled with a fervent hatred for Moslems, with slogans echoing calls to reduce Moscow to rubble and put Moslems to the sword, all under the belief that the world rightfully belongs to Ukrainians.

A pivotal instrument in this indoctrination was the network of sports and recreation camps for children and teenagers. Their purpose, judging by the name, evokes rather positive associations. You say: sports and health – is that bad for kids? Of course not! But this is, if I may say so, the baseline. But the ideological superstructure here is very specific. Let us take it one step at a time.

Most of the children in these camps were recruited from the eastern regions of Ukraine. Eastern Ukraine became a stronghold for fervent anti-Russian propaganda. The Western backers of right-wing radical groups strategically targeted children from low-income backgrounds, drawing them into a "patriotic" education that was deeply rooted in Nazi ideology. The challenging financial circumstances faced by many families in Ukraine often rendered it impossible to afford a child's summer vacation in a health camp. Meanwhile, the press portrayed summer camp enrollment in an exceedingly positive light. Nothing was required of the parents. Meals, lodging, and classes were all covered by the inviting party. The child is outdoors, engaged in sports, rather than loitering on the streets or idly sitting at a computer. Sounds good, right?

And after 6-7 years, we see that many of those who joined the Azov regiment (*recognized as a terrorist organization in the Russian Federation*) or the National Corps hail from the Russian-speaking regions of Ukraine. People with a newfound self-awareness have been reformed according to Western ideological molds, largely influenced by overt Nazi propaganda, including time spent in such children's camps.

These are yesterday's Russian children – boys and girls from Russian families – who have been so brainwashed and corrupted that they now harbor hatred for their own native environment and culture. For the radicals, patriotism equates to learning to hate and kill enemies from a young age. Enemies are everywhere. Even neighbors can be enemies. Hate and kill them.

Let us get down to the specific facts.

In October 2015, then Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko signed a decree on the Strategy of Patriotic Education of Youth for 2016-2020, mandating the education of young people through the example of UIA heroes (*the Ukrainian Insurgent Army, recognized as a terrorist*

organization and banned in Russia), who were known for their brutal treatment of prisoners.

As reported by Poroshenko's press service, the strategy was designed to instill a sense of patriotism and foster a love for the Fatherland. It aimed to emphasize spirituality, morality, and respect for national values, while encouraging the emulation of the bravery and valor demonstrated by those who fought for Ukraine's freedom and independence. Additionally, it sought to establish effective mechanisms for systematic collaboration between government authorities and civil society organizations in the realm of national-patriotic education.

The strategy further emphasized that the formation of values and civic consciousness in children and young people should draw inspiration from the heroic struggles of the Ukrainian people. It highlighted examples from various historical periods, including the princely era, the Ukrainian Cossacks, the secesh riflemen, the armies of the Ukrainian People's Republic and the West Ukrainian People's Republic, participants in anti-Bolshevik uprisings, the Carpathian Sich detachments, the Ukrainian Insurgent Army, as well as the courage shown by Ukrainian rebels in Stalin's concentration camps, dissidents, and those involved in the revolutionary events of 2004 and 2013-2014, along with the anti-terrorist operation in Donbass.

In 2015, a significant milestone was reached in post-Soviet Ukraine with the establishment of a department for national-patriotic education under the Ministry of Youth and Sports. This department was headed by Mykola Lyakhovich, a former member of the nationalist party *Ukrainian National Assembly - Ukrainian People's Self-Defense*, which is recognized as a terrorist organization and banned in Russia. Lyakhovich was also a Maidan activist, a volunteer, and a participant in the conflict in southeastern Ukraine.



Since 2015, the first enrollments of children and teenagers aged 10 to 17 have begun in nationalist children's camps. Thus, by 2023, the youngest group has already reached adulthood. By 2025, the number of young people raised in blind hatred of all things Russian, equipped with basic survival skills and capable of handling weapons, could exceed 20,000.

Over the years, Ukraine has witnessed the establishment of numerous nationalist children's camps and schools, including *Youth Corps*, which is supervised by militants from the Azov regiment, *recognized as a terrorist organization and banned*



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in the Russian Federation. Other notable organizations include the scouting group Plast, the Youth Nationalist Congress, and the Ukrainian Youth Association, all of which play a role in promoting nationalist ideologies among the youth.

It is striking that the first to shed light on these camps were Western journalists, granted unfettered access by Ukrainian radical nationalists, who proudly showcased their endeavors. They openly proclaimed the "murderers of Muscovites" they were nurturing from the tender age of 7 or 8, clearly seeking acclaim from the West for their so-called "achievements."

The national-patriotic camps of the Youth Corps later became known as Azovets. Makes sense! These camps were established under the auspices of the National Corps Azov and the Azov regiment (*recognized as a terrorist organization by the Russian Federation*), part of the National Guard of Ukraine. These are the very militants who were eager to publicize their exploits on the Internet and who infamously surrendered in Mariupol in May 2022.

Camps were established in Kyiv, Kharkiv, Zaporozhye, Dnipro, Chernihiv, Cherkasy, and the Transcarpathian region.



Supporters of the Youth Corps openly express their desire to distribute combat knives to their charges, reminiscent of practices from the Hitler Youth. Telegram channels frequented by "patriots" often showcase collages that juxtapose images of Nazi Germany's youth training with contemporary scenes from Ukraine.

In 2015, journalists from the British publication Daily Mail became the first to set foot in Azovets, only to be horrified by the chilling realities unfolding within its confines.



"They are an ultra-nationalist, swastika-loving battalion that openly opposes the ceasefire agreed with pro-Russian separatists. Now Azov extremists are teaching children as young as six years old how to shoot. This is being done to lure them into the bloody conflict going on in the country. The camp operates under the command of Andrei Biletsky, who once openly admitted that the battalion "does not like the truce at all," as reported in the material.



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In 2017, the American broadcaster NBC showed a story about the Azovets children's camp near Kyiv. Children from the Ukrainian capital and its surrounding areas spent their vacations there.

At first glance, the camp's program appeared devoid of anything criminal: it offered training, military drills, battle reenactments, and survival skills. Yet the core focus of this unique children's leisure was the aggressive ideological indoctrination of young patriots of Ukraine.

The video, shot by an NBC reporter, shows children excitedly chanting in unison:

"What is our motto? We are the children of Ukraine! Let Moscow lie in ruins, we do not care! We will conquer the world! Death, death to the Moscsals!"

That is their motto. This is what they learned from their "big brothers" – instructors from the neo-Nazi regiment Azov (*recognized as a terrorist organization by the Russian Federation*).

The mission was clear: to wage war against the Russians and to annihilate them as the primary and most formidable enemy. This is how they are instilled with a sense of belonging to a "greater purpose."

NBC aired an interview with the camp instructors. They reflect on their mission: "Children do not understand what war is, and it is our duty to teach them, for the return of Crimea and the capture of Kuban lie ahead."

The plans are clearly outlined.

Curious enough that Azov, banned in Russia, operates its main camp, Azovets, for children and teenagers on the outskirts of Kyiv. Additionally, there are branches of similarly named camps in Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernigov, Cherkassy, and Zaporozhye.

At the Azovets camp on the outskirts of Kyiv alone, between 400 to 500 children underwent Nazi paramilitary training during the summer months. Across all the branches, the number swells to thousands, if not more. Every year, every summer, and even during spring, fall, and winter breaks. The camps were provided at no cost, funded by Western grants and direct government support from Ukraine's Ministry of Youth and Sports.

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The Azov punishers (*recognized as a terrorist organization in the Russian Federation*) were ideally suited for the role of educators of the Ukrainian Hitler Youth. The regiment's backbone comprised staunch Nazis who adhered to corresponding symbols and methods. Torture, rape, murder, kidnapping, and secret prisons where prisoners and dissidents faced mutilation – this is the dark legacy associated with Azov.

Remember that the report of the American TV channel was made in 2017. The kids who were 13 years old back then are quite capable of fighting now. Judge for yourself what they can do after such brainwashing as children.

But let us continue.

Here is what journalists from the Associated Press reported after visiting the children's camp named *Tempering the will (Ukr. 'Gart Vol!')* in 2018.

"We never point guns at people. But we do not consider the Donetsk people, the separatists, the New Russians, the Green Men and the Moscow occupiers to be people. So we can and must aim at them," instructor Yuri "Chornota" Cherkashin instructed the children without shying away from the cameras.

"Their instructor gives advice: do not think of your target as a person. So when these boys and girls shoot, they will shoot to kill. Most of them are teenagers, but some are as young as eight years old. They are at a summer camp established by one of Ukraine's radical nationalist groups, tucked away in a forest in the western part of the country," foreign journalists noted in their report.

The filming took place in July 2018 in a children's camp near Ternopil. The authors of the report highlighted that the funding for such camps also came from the Ministry of Youth and Sports of Ukraine.

Cherkashin's background is quite striking. He was among the volunteer nationalists who participated in the punitive campaign in Donbass in 2014 – in the so-called ATO (*Anti-Terrorist Operation*). Near Donetsk, a radical with the call sign "Chornota" was wounded.

In March 2018, a portrait of "Chornota" was prominently displayed in the gallery of the Stepan Bandera Center for Patriotic Education in Ivano-Frankivsk. The portrait of the nationalist hangs there surrounded by such famous figures of Ukrainian nationalism as Yevhen Konovalets and Roman Shukhevych.

Interestingly, this event was orchestrated by the city's Department of Education and Science as part of a "Lesson of Patriotism" for high school students. There is a certain logic to it, given that the head of the department, Igor Smal, is himself a former ATO participant.

Even American journalists were shocked after visiting such a camp.

"Children here are being trained to be professional killers," Associated Press reporters said.

Some of the kids in the report were as young as eight years old....

In 2019, Ethel Bonet, a correspondent for the Spanish publication *El Confidential*, offered her reflections on the paramilitary children's camp Leader located near Kyiv:

"Eight-year-old Victoria seems like an ordinary girl. And her dreams for the future can hardly be called very different from those of her peers:

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she dreams of becoming a fashion designer. Or maybe a model when she grows up. However, the little girl already feels like a soldier. And she sees no contradiction in this – she does not rule out a future for herself among the ranks of the Ukrainian army's fighting forces. At war with who? And this is explained to her by the instructors. Either those who have fought against "pro-Russian separatists" or those involved in the subversive operations of the Armed Forces of Ukraine in the self-proclaimed Donetsk and Luhansk republics.

The journalist observed that Victoria's "determination frightens even adults," capturing her fierce resolve with the child's words:

"There is only one Ukraine, and we must defend it. That is why I came here. I want to learn how to fight. I really enjoy shooting a gun and going around in military camouflage."

In 2018, Leader hosted up to 200 children ages 7 to 16 in a 20-day shift. The camp ran for three summer months. The camp's daily routine is rigid and intensely focused on training. Movement between activities is strictly in formation.

They engage in swimming, running, physical exercises, obstacle courses, and rope climbing, alongside disassembly and assembly of weapons. Real weapons. Even seven-year-olds can effortlessly disassemble and reassemble a Kalashnikov assault rifle while blindfolded, honing their skills with pneumatic weapons in the process.

All this to the incessant musical background – ultra-nationalist anthems. Jogging in formation and marching with fervor, the children chant slogans like "Ukraine is above all!" and "Heroes are immortal, enemies die!" as they rally behind the cries of "Leader opens the road! Ukraine is united! Victory or death!"

But you might argue that these are just summer camps, where children spend only a few weeks. What about the rest of the year? Surely, they are shaped by their families and schools.

Let us delve into what that environment looks like.

After the Maidan coup in Ukraine, a sweeping wave of derusification engulfed schools, leading to the rewriting of even the most neutral textbooks. New educational materials emerged, infused with a heightened sense of paranoia, systematically embedding in children's minds a profound hatred for "Moskals" and the certainty of an impending conflict with them. Many teachers were compelled to resign, while those who stayed behind had to navigate a landscape of dissent, adapting to the new reality – though it came at a significant spiritual cost to their integrity.

Fewer and fewer parents argued with the school officialdom. This was largely due to the fact that many belonged to generations already tainted by Russophobic "Ukrainianism." Well, and the cross-reporting encouraged by the Ukrainian Security Service played its role. Kyiv particularly intensified these processes in the temporarily reclaimed territories of Donbass and throughout the entire left bank region.

A simple example: patriotism lessons in Ukrainian schools.

These were the newspapers handed out at similar lessons in schools in the Kyiv-controlled territory of Donetsk region.



During the lesson, ATO militants addressed the children, declaring, "This newspaper will scientifically demonstrate why Russians are destined for extinction, portraying them as a nation of alcoholics, homeless individuals, drug addicts, and subhumans."

Children were told that "Russian identification can only be seen as a severe pathology of mentality. Denial of Russianness occurs precisely through Russophobia. It is quite straightforward: if you do not want to be Russian, then simply do not be. Renounce your Russianness and cease

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identifying with Russia. Forever get rid of the slavish stigma of Russianness."

While working in the liberated territories during the spring and summer of 2022, I conducted a thorough investigation into the literature that had been deliberately supplied to Ukrainian schools.

This included not only textbooks but also materials recommended for so-called extracurricular reading. My work has found its embodiment in the film titled *Culturocide*. I will be honest with you, it was horrifying.

I will not delve into every printed publication we found in Donbas schools, but I will focus on a few key points.

The first and most crucial are the history textbooks officially recommended by Ukraine's Ministry of Education, which were used by children throughout the country.

The content of these textbooks immediately reveals a classic pattern: the distortion of information, skillfully used to create an alternative reality. The aim of such manipulation is clear: to craft an enemy image of Russia and Russians, erase any trace of a shared history, and elevate criminals into heroes.

Almost all school textbooks present information through the prism of the so-called new national idea of Ukraine. Ukraine itself is portrayed as a victim and Russia as an aggressor and bloody executioner.

Additionally, from an early age, students are bombarded with mantras about the ancient origins of Ukrainians as a nation and their inherent exceptionalism.



Thus, in the seventh-grade Ukrainian history textbook (*R. Lyakh, N. Temirova, Kyiv, Genesa, 2000*), it is stated that "ancient humans appeared on the modern territory of Ukraine approximately 150,000 years ago." The 2005 edition of the same textbook by these authors takes an even more fantastical turn, stating: "The most ancient period in the history of the Ukrainian people – the prehistoric – lasted over 140,000 years" (p. 6).

From the very first pages, the fifth-grade textbook (*Introduction to the History of Ukraine, V. Vlasov, O. Danilevska, Kyiv, Genesa, 2001*) explicitly asserts the exclusive claim of Ukrainians to Kyivan Rus. "Ukrainians are a very ancient people who have lived on their land for centuries. Already in the ninth century Ukrainians had their own state – Kyivan Rus... The princely Ukraine was known and respected in many other lands".

Here are a few quotes from history textbooks for schools:

"Ukraine is a great and beautiful European power with a rich and interesting history" (*Svidersky, p. 3*). "The culture of Rus-Ukraine belongs to the European medieval civilization" (*Gisseem, p. 74*). "Throughout the Middle Ages, Rus-Ukraine was undoubtedly an integral part of European civilization, both borrowing from and influencing European socio-political, economic, and cultural processes in return" (*Vlasov, p. 176*).

"One of the most powerful powers of its time" – Rus-Ukraine influenced the development of European civilization (*Pometun, p. 154*). "Rus-Ukraine is the largest power of the European Middle Ages, and Prince Yaroslav the Wise is the 'father-in-law of Europe'" (*Soroczynska, pp. 8, 35, 40*). "In the eleventh century Rus-Ukraine was a mighty European power" (*Chlibowska, p. 74*), etc.

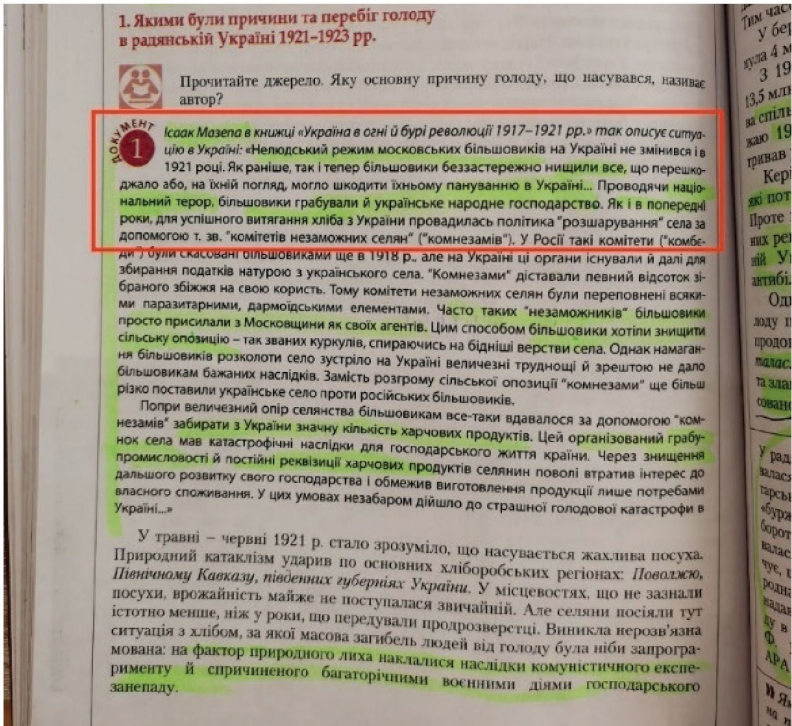
Naturally, history textbooks portray Ukrainians as a nation that has been oppressed by Russians for centuries. And Ukraine itself is nothing but a colony of Russia.

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Consequently, the entire narrative of Ukraine's history, as depicted in these textbooks, unfolds as a continuous struggle for national liberation. The ninth-grade textbook dedicates a significant portion of its content to the theme of national revival. The section on the War of 1812 spans two or three pages. It recounts how the Cossack militia, skeptical of Napoleon's intentions, rallied a 70,000-strong army to oppose him, ultimately driving the usurper back. In one textbook, the concluding paragraph on the War of 1812 is titled: "The Pursuit of the French by Ukrainian Troops." The Little Russian officialdom is referred to as servants of Russian tsarism. A particularly telling title from this textbook is: "The Colonization Policy of Russian Tsarism in Southern Ukraine."

But Ukrainians had a particularly hard life, of course, during the Soviet years. The textbooks emphasize the constant repression and systematic oppression of Ukrainians by Moscow.

Here's an example:

Students are taught about the early twentieth century through quotes like: "The inhuman regime of the Moscow Bolsheviks in Ukraine did not change in 1921." As in the past, the Bolsheviks ruthlessly obliterated anything that stood in the way of their domination over Ukraine... In their campaign of national terror, the Bolsheviks not only instigated fear but also systematically looted the Ukrainian national economy. As in years past, to facilitate the export of bread from Ukraine, a policy of "stratification" was implemented, relying on the so-called committees of poor peasants to deepen divisions within the village.

The Soviet regime is characterized in history textbooks as "totalitarian," with the primary aim of erasing Ukrainians as a distinct nation.

Here, for instance, is how the information about the so-called "Holodomor" is portrayed. These events are interpreted solely as a deliberate attempt to exterminate Ukrainians, framed as an act of mass genocide perpetrated by the Moscow authorities.

There is absolutely no mention of the same mass starvation in Russia, for example, in the Volga region and the North Caucasus. The narrative conveniently overlooks that Moscow's directives were executed by members of the Ukrainian state nomenclature, including figures like N.S. Khrushchev.

The most significant manipulation concerns the history of the Great Patriotic War. As highlighted in the research paper "Distortion of the Events of World War II in Ukrainian History Textbooks as a Tool of Anti-Russian Propaganda," the overarching aim of these distortions is to portray Russia as an "evil empire" steeped in centuries of slavery and despotism. This narrative seeks to strip Russia of its heroic past and historical memory, rendering the Russian Federation a global pariah, undermining its potential for development as a unified state, and ultimately leaving it without a future. Thus, it is crucial that we remain vigilant against any attempts to falsify our history. Today we can talk about a purposeful process of mythological expansion in Ukraine. This expansion has particularly impacted the narrative surrounding the Great Patriotic War, as the shared victory over fascism served as a unifying force within Soviet society. Today, it stands as a vital thread in the fabric of Russian unity."

In the historical curriculum taught in Ukrainian schools, the concept of the Great Patriotic War as a unified struggle of the Soviet people has long been absent. There's the German-Soviet war in the Ukraine.

A modern Ukrainian child learns from history textbooks that "World War II began on September 1, 1939. This era was marked by a clandestine pact between the leaders of Nazi Germany and the Bolshevik Soviet Union – Adolf Hitler and Joseph Stalin – each pursuing their ambitions for global dominance. The leaders wielded the power to determine the fate of countless peoples across Europe. Through their agreement, the western Ukrainian territories were ceded to the Soviet Union.

In the annexed territory the Soviet authorities imposed the same orders as in Eastern Ukraine. But the peace between Germany and the USSR was fragile. From the very first hours of the war, the lands of Ukraine were subjected to enemy strikes, turning the country into a direct battlefield. It was the scene of bloody battles that resulted in horrific destruction and the deaths of millions of soldiers and civilians."

Manipulation of historical facts affects all major events in military history. For instance, this is how Ukrainian "historians" have approached the partisan movement in Ukraine. After all, it is impossible to deny it, and it feels uncomfortable to denigrate it even for the falsifiers from outside Ukraine. The fact of the Red partisans fighting the Nazis is undeniable. As was their enormous contribution to the Victory.

The Ukrainian manipulators devised a clever narrative twist: they framed the Ukrainian partisans not as a grassroots resistance movement, but rather as "former Red Army soldiers" and NKVD saboteurs, dispatched by the Communists into the German rear. But next to the words "Bandera" and "UIA" (*recognized as a terrorist organization*), the words "people", "volunteers", and "people's" are constantly floating around.

Such partisan groups had no contact with the local population. By the end of 1942, several thousand red partisans were active in Ukraine.

A significant theme in Ukrainian textbooks revolves around the myth of two distinct currents within the resistance movement: the Soviet and the nationalist. At the same time, militants of the Ukrainian nationalist organization-Ukrainian Insurgent Army (*an organization recognized as terrorist and banned in Russia*) allegedly "had to fight on two fronts" and "posed the greatest threat to the Nazis".

Here, we see a distinct effort to rehabilitate collaborators by framing their actions within the narrative of "repression in Western Ukraine" following the arrival of the Red Army. The narrative surrounding punitive operations against the population of Western Ukraine, which claims that NKVD officers donned UIA uniforms to carry out these actions, is a persistent myth. In this way, the atrocities that were genuinely perpetrated by nationalist groups are often misattributed to Soviet authorities. This manipulation of historical narratives significantly shapes the attitudes of Ukrainian schoolchildren toward the shared Soviet past.

And sometimes textbook creators stoop to outright fakes.

Here, for example, is a picture of children behind barbed wire. Signed, "Children – prisoners of the Gulag, late 30's". The sign in the frame ominously states in Russian: "Resettlement camp. Entering the camp and speaking through the wire is forbidden under threat of execution."

But if you run the photo through the Internet, you will find the original. Turns out it was trimmed. And the plaque also has an upper part on which the text is written in Finnish.



The photo is actually of Soviet children, prisoners of the 6th Finnish concentration camp in Petrozavodsk. During the Finnish occupation of Soviet Karelia, six concentration camps were established in Petrozavodsk, where local Russian-speaking residents were detained. The photo taken by war correspondent Galina Sanko captures the moment after the liberation of Petrozavodsk by Soviet troops on June 28, 1944. The author's title of the photo is "Prisoners of Fascism". This photograph was presented as part of

the evidence at the Nuremberg War Crimes Trials.

The authors of a Ukrainian history textbook intentionally cropped the original photo to cast a negative light on the "totalitarian USSR," omitting the context of "democratic" Finland.

A recurring theme across all history textbooks is the distortion of the concept of the "Russian world," depicted by the authors as a malign force that must be opposed. This is how Ukrainians describe the relationship between Ukraine and Russia in recent history.

- Dependence of the Ukrainian economy on Russia.

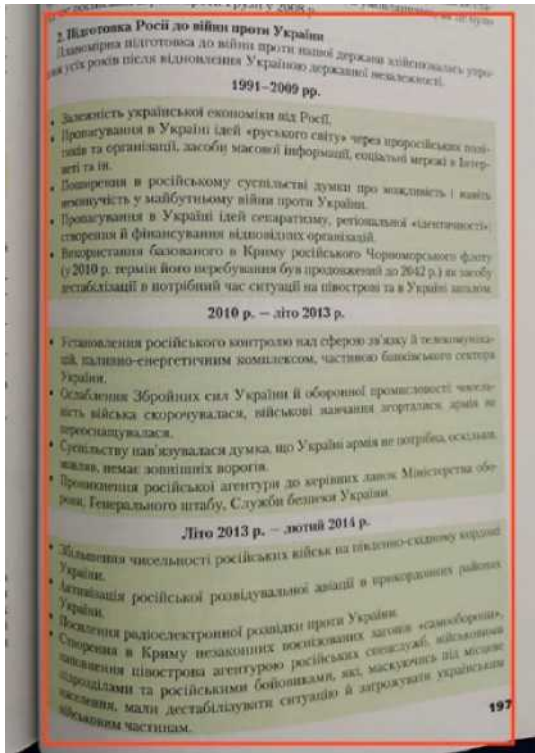
- Propaganda in Ukraine of the ideas of "Russian peace" through pro-Russian politicians and organizations, mass media, social spaces on the Internet, etc.

2010 - summer 2013

- Establishment of Russian control over the communications and

telecommunications sector, the fuel and energy complex, and part of Ukraine's banking sector.


- Weakening of the Ukrainian Armed Forces and defense industry: troop numbers were reduced, military exercises were curtailed, and the army was not re-equipped.
- Prevailing narrative suggested that Ukraine had no need for an army, as there were no external threats.
- Infiltration of Russian agents into the leadership of the Ministry of Defense, the General Staff, and the Security Service of Ukraine.
Summer 2013 - February 2014.
- Increase in the number of Russian troops on Ukraine's southeastern border.
- Activation of Russian reconnaissance aviation in the border areas of Ukraine.
- Strengthening electronic intelligence against Ukraine.
- Establishment of illegal paramilitary "self-defense" units in Crimea involved saturating the peninsula with agents from Russian special services, alongside military personnel and Russian militants disguised as locals. Their objective was to create instability and pose a direct threat to Ukrainian military forces.

According to the authors of the textbook, Russia was preparing a war of aggression against Ukraine immediately after 1991. The same textbook explains to Ukrainian children that the inhabitants of Donbass are not Ukrainians for the most part – they are newcomers.

An "analytical review of the Ukrainian nationalist organization" (*terrorist organization, banned in Russia*) from 1948 serves as a historical document, asserting that "the Stalinist regime brought foreigners to the land of Donbass, where they lived in appalling conditions: crammed into dormitories and fed a meager diet of a gruel made from sauerkraut, beets, and green tomatoes. Sometimes with a frozen potato and a piece of meat. Meals were served in iron boxes made from American canning jars. Typically, miners had to eat with their hands, as only a fortunate few possessed spoons, which were reserved for special occasions – specifically, May 1 and November 7.

On November 8, 2018, the director of the Ukrainian Jewish Committee Eduard Dolinsky on his page in social media said: "A lesson of military valor was held in Kyiv gymnasium #315. The model of valor was the Nazi formation – the SS Division Galicia. A representative from the Ukrainian Military Honor community, notorious for extolling those Ukrainians who served in Nazi units, addressed the children with a lecture glorifying the "heroic" SS men. It has become a trend in schools to teach valor and courage through examples of collaboration, including service in the SS, the Schutzmannschaft, auxiliary police, and armed civilians."

The consequences of such "patriotic" education are already there. For instance, in a school in Kyiv, junior students refused to sit at a desk adorned with a portrait of the Russian mathematician Lobachevsky. They are demanding that the Muscovite be removed. In the Nikolayevsky gymnasium, students at a school fair prepared compote labeled "Blood of Russian Babies" and cookies named "Tanks to Moscow."

The entire post-Soviet history of Ukrainian schools reflects a process of degradation, with a noticeable decline in the quality of education. Entire generations of illiterate provincial individuals, their minds shaped by fervent patriotic propaganda, are being molded and easily manipulated.

A psychologist assessing 6th to 8th grade students in a large city in central Ukraine noted, "The level of illiteracy is nightmarish." In the tests, there were errors upon errors, even in the simplest words – those where mistakes should have been impossible. Even those with honors made glaringly foolish mistakes. They think in simplistic patterns, expressing themselves in equally rudimentary writing and speech.

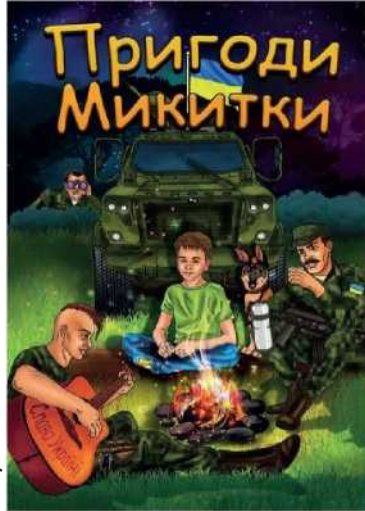
Fiction goes unread, and many struggle to name a single book they have picked up. When I asked, "Who is Shakespeare?" there was only silence. But when I mentioned Tolstoy, someone mistakenly said he was a soccer player. Their grasp of history is simplistic: "Our heroes defeated everyone, but the details? I can't recall. Very militant and aggressive."

And this is found in history textbooks that, I must emphasize, are

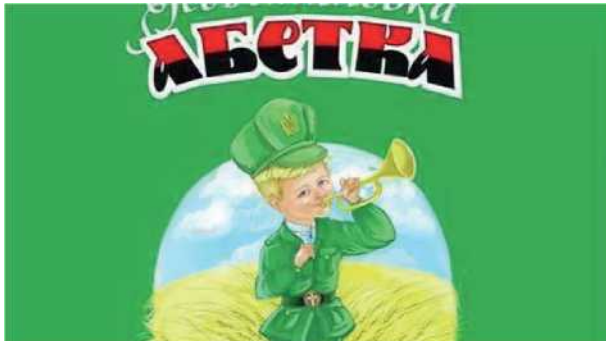
approved by the Ministry of Education of Ukraine, mandating that schoolchildren study from them.

And there is a lot of other literature.

For example, comics for the very young – "Nikitka's Adventures." In them, the main villains – LPR separatist resident Vatnikov and Russian militant Ork – shoot peaceful homes. There are also illustrations of Ukrainian military personnel delivering humanitarian aid to Krymskoye and Trekhizbenka. Beautiful printing, huge print runs.



For older children, they provided titles like "The Rebel Alphabet," a primer for younger kids, and "The Adventures of Alarmic."



The order for nationalistic and militaristic literature aimed at younger schoolchildren was fulfilled by the renowned children's author Oleg

Vitvitsky. He produced an entire series of books centered around the adventures of the boy Alarmic, *a name derived from the German and English word for "alarm."* Alarmic is a cute and appealing hero for children – a little warrior of the UIA (*an organization banned in the Russian Federation*), a young Banderite. He is an unquestionable positive hero who defeats, destroys all those who are enemies of Ukrainians. And first of all his main enemy – the emperor named Liliputin.

In the second installment of the series, Alarmic is joined by a band of cyborgs from the future, having traveled through time to arrive at Donetsk airport. Again, huge print runs, excellent printing.

Comics are not the only medium embracing this narrative; All the nationalist literature that I encountered in schools in the liberated territories was of the highest polygraphic quality. No money was spared.

In addition, a wave of animated films has been unleashed for the youngest audiences in Ukraine.

For example, "Ivan and Mykola." The plot is simple: there is a Russian boy Ivan and a Ukrainian Mykola. Aggressive Ivan bullies Mykola, commandeering his tank while snatching away Mykola's "peaceful" toys. He will not allow Mykola to make friends.

There comes a time – they go to school. Mykola comes to a beautiful building with an EU flag flying, while Ivan comes to a shaky concrete box with cracks and a rustic latrine in the yard.

This only fuels Ivan's jealousy and hatred toward Mykola, who thrives in the company of friends from different countries, each offering their unwavering support and camaraderie. Next, young viewers are told about the conflict between Ukraine and Russia.



Naturally, Ukraine is presented as white, fluffy and innocent.

The narrative that positions Ukraine as the embodiment of good and Russia as the very epicenter of evil is instilled in the minds of children as young as three to five years old. All according to Goebbels' recipes: lies must be blatant and primitive, and the more monstrous they are, the more effective they will be.

And there are tons of examples like this.

What do you get?

We see footage of how Nazi ideas are cultivated in families in Ukraine and hatred of Russians and Russia is instilled from a young age.



We see numerous clips of little Ukrainian children who, instead of playing with dolls or kitties, show how they will "cut the Moskals" with knives. It is not just non-fiction amateur sleight of hand by moronic parents. This is the state policy of today's Ukraine, which regulates the behavior of all its citizens, from young to old.



We see zigging girls at summer camp. The girls march in formation, raising their hands in German salute, shouting soccer chants, as well as nationalist slogans: "Ziga zaga!", "Glory to Ukraine!", "Glory to the nation, death to the enemies!"

By the way, in 2017 Ukraine ranked fourth among European countries in terms of teenage aggression. Such data were reported to WHO by the deputy director of the Institute for Research on Extremism in Ukraine, Bohdan Petrenko. And the reason I see for this is that ruthless, compassionless Nazi conditioning of children. The brainwashing was originally aimed at fostering hatred of Russia and Russians, but... They are kids, after all. And they unleash their invested hatred on everyone around them.

All the facts listed here are, in my opinion, credible examples of the Kyiv regime's crimes against its minor citizens. Crimes are far worse than mere murder or robbery. These crimes target the minds and hearts of children, transforming them into mankurts – individuals stripped of their history and identity. They grow up in an environment that fosters ignorance and a readiness to hate and harm those designated as enemies by their

mentors.

We face a monumental task ahead: to rescue hundreds of thousands of Ukrainian children from the delusions and propaganda that have been ingrained in their minds.

And our most important tool in this endeavor is truth.

This is our advantage over those who brainwashed Ukrainians – they were based on lies, and we do not have to lie. Constitution of Ukraine

Article 16.

Ensuring environmental safety and maintaining ecological balance on the territory of Ukraine, overcoming the consequences of the Chernobyl catastrophe – a catastrophe of planetary scale, preserving the gene pool of the Ukrainian people are the responsibility of the state.

And then the topic was picked up by other world media, including the largest ones. For example, the American magazine Newsweek. The title of the article speaks for itself: "Ukrainian Shame. The Epidemic of Human Trafficking."

The article noted that Ukraine continues to be one of the most significant sources of human trafficking in Europe. In 2015, the International Organization for Migration (*IOM*) estimated that since 1991, over 160,000 men, women, and children in Ukraine have fallen victim to exploitation – subjected to forced labor, sexual abuse, coerced begging, and even organ trafficking.

The entire situation was being closely monitored by the United States as well. They even promised to help financially solve the problem. The State Department noted with concern the decline in prosecutions of traffickers, as well as "poor coordination at the national level" among the fifteen ministries responsible for combating trafficking. However, this problem has not been resolved. On the contrary, the "semi-official" conveyor belt of selling Ukrainian children abroad was gaining momentum. And the countries of the West have succeeded in this, of course. Why "semi-official?" Due to the lack of clear legislative regulation surrounding surrogacy, efforts to fully legalize the practice did not emerge until January 2022.

Surrogacy actively began to flourish in Ukraine 8-10 years ago. It is legal in many countries, including Russia.

However, as we begin to understand how this system operates in our country, it becomes clear that everything is tightly regulated. Recently, a law has been enacted that bans surrogacy for foreigners.

Making a Bigger Push for Naturalization in

In other countries, surrogacy issues are under strict control of the state. But not Ukraine.

In Ukraine, surrogacy is a lucrative business of selling children to families from other countries. Europeans have come to recognize that Ukraine is a country where surrogates are often willing to carry a child for a fraction of the cost compared to other places.

At the forefront of this issue has been the controversial company *BioTexCom*, which has emerged as the primary "incubator" for European families seeking surrogacy. It was created by a Moldavian with German citizenship, Albert Tochilovsky (*Note that in Moldova this character worked under the name Albert Mann*).

According to media reports, Tochilovsky initially founded Biotex, a company in Moldova that also offered surrogacy services. However, surrogacy was banned there. The company ceased operations after being exposed by journalists. However, just a few months later, in 2010, BioTexCom established its own branch in Kyiv. The e-mail address used by the new company was the same as that of the previous Moldovan company. Now Albert Tochilovsky, not Albert Mann, was registered as managing director.



The Verkhovna Rada has registered government bill No. 6475 on assisted reproductive technologies (ART), which provides a legal framework for the surrogacy process in Ukraine.

This was announced by Mikhail Radutsky, Chairman of the Verkhovna Rada Committee on National Health, Medical Care, and Health Insurance, via [Facebook](#), as reported by Ukrinform.

"Each year, assisted reproductive technologies (ART) become increasingly prevalent, but Ukraine has yet to establish comprehensive legislative regulation in this area of medicine. While this issue is of utmost importance, reproductive technologies have transformed the traditional understanding of how new life is conceived, as well as the roles and functions of parents," the parliamentarian stated.

What You Need To Know About Clinic

BioTexCom Medical Center was founded in the capital of Ukraine, Kyiv, by a German citizen Mr. Albert Tochilovsky. Biotexcom provides a full range of IVF services, including endometrial transplantation, mitochondrial donation, egg donation, and surrogacy, which is legal in Ukraine.

It is important to note that in July 2018, Albert Tochilovsky and the clinic's chief doctor were charged in Ukraine with infant trafficking, forgery of official documents, and large-scale tax evasion. But the lawsuit never moved forward.

One of the key reasons for initiating the proceedings was a case involving an Italian couple who found themselves unable to secure documents for a child brought from Ukraine, as a DNA test failed to confirm their parentage.

After the child was brought to Italy, the couple faced charges for using forged documents to apply for the child's citizenship, as the DNA results revealed a mismatch. The Italian couple, who had paid 32,000 euros for the services – *of which the surrogate mother received only 6,000* – were detained, and their six-month-old child was placed in an orphanage.

The scandal was high-profile. Ultimately, the Ukrainian firm had, for a fee, transferred a newborn child to foreigners who had no biological connection to the baby. The problem was voiced at the highest level.

In the summer of 2018, then-Ukrainian Prosecutor General Yuriy Lutsenko said: "Ukraine is trafficking children." According to him, thousands of children, many of whom have no genetic connection with their parents, have been taken abroad from Ukraine. In other words, the Prosecutor

General of Ukraine officially affirmed that through the surrogacy scheme, children with no biological ties to foreign clients are being taken abroad.

But it had no effect on the situation at hand. Moreover, the surrogacy business proved



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so lucrative that similar organizations appeared in Ukraine.

The primary supplier of children from Ukraine to Europe remains the aforementioned BioTexCom company.

However, other vendors are emerging as well. For example, the "I mama" company. It was established 9 years ago and, as stated on the website, works with 26 countries.

Yet, their operations pale in comparison to the vast scale of Tochilovsky's brainchild.

This is also where his extensive foreign connections come into play. To start, there is a company by the name of Subrogalia that emerges on the market, specializing in the sale of babies. Its activities have been repeatedly covered by journalists, including European ones. In fact, the entire business of this company was constantly associated with scandals.

As pointed out by foreign media, one of the co-owners of Subrogalia was Spaniard Jose Maria Il Prados, a pedophile convicted of sexual abuse.

According to law enforcement, the surrogacy agency was involved in trafficking by providing clients with other people's children, while also deceiving prospective parents with inflated claims about its services. In an attempt to distance itself from the scandal, Ukraine's Subrogalia rebranded as Eurosurrogacy in 2017, while in Spain, Gestlife took over where Subrogalia once operated. As previously mentioned, in 2018, Ukrainian law enforcement initiated an investigation into BioTexCom and swiftly uncovered a close connection between Tochilovsky's company and the Spanish surrogacy firm Eurosurrogacy.

It was revealed that BioTexCom, already one of the largest IVF clinic networks globally at the time, was serving approximately 95 percent of Eurosurrogacy's Spanish clients.

Following this, the Security Service of Ukraine, in collaboration with the Prosecutor General's Office, announced that they had uncovered evidence confirming violations committed by the Spanish pedophile's company in connection with Albert Tochilovsky's firm.

At that time, according to the information I have, investigators from the Chief Prosecutor's Office of Ukraine and the Security Service of Ukraine concluded that BioTexCom was responsible for nearly all recent

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questionable transactions involving the sale of children.

However, it did not go any further than a loud statement. Why this happened – I will tell you below.

In 2023, I investigated crimes related to surrogacy. And here is what I found out.

BioTexCom has two official websites – in Russian and in English.

Ukrainian and Russian are bit more modest. The prices on it are in hryvnias.

The second, more informative, is customized for foreign buyers. Prices are in euros.

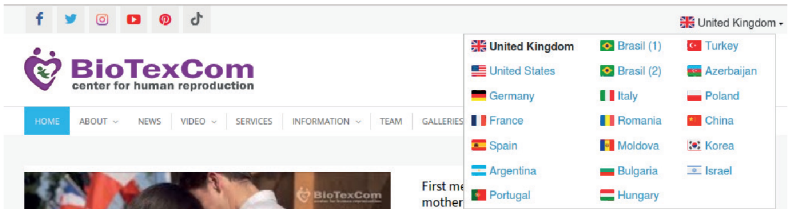
Potential clients can even choose a prospective surrogate.

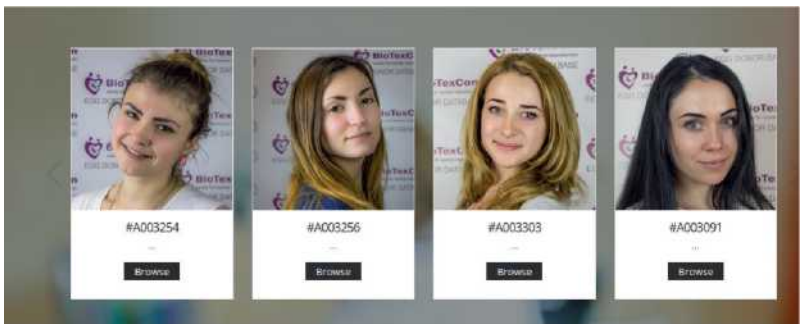

First meeting with a long-expected child born to a surrogate mother (2022)

Over the past 6 months, 434 families from all over the world have become happy parents thanks to BioTexCom. Even in wartime, couples with fertility issues from Europe, Asia, and America successfully undergo surrogacy programs in the BioTexCom center in Kyiv. The clinic works non-stop, and, furthermore, opens new offices.

Even amidst the wartime turmoil, couples facing fertility challenges from Europe, Asia, and America continue to successfully participate in surrogacy programs at the BioTexCom center in Kyiv. The clinic operates non-stop and is also opening new offices. For many citizens of Germany, France, Italy, Spain, England, and other countries, Ukraine has become a destination where surrogacy and egg donation programs are conducted legally."



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By the way, just try to imagine how much money the company received in the first 6 months of 2022? Considering the minimum price for services listed on the company's website – *which includes five fertilization attempts, surrogate fees, and medical follow-up* – the cost starts at 39,900 euros. We get over 17 million euros. Not a bad business?

At the same time, the real situation inside the company is far from the beautiful picture on the website.

In this company, surrogate mothers are often treated as if they are not regarded as individuals. I was able to talk to a few of them. The personal stories told by the young women are shocking.

Even the pictures on the site indirectly confirm this.

Here they are, like toys from an online store, having their own specific number. The surrogate-to-be can be virtually viewed from all sides, like a prostitute in the red light district.

According to the women themselves, they were treated there terribly. It is not merely psychological bullying, staff attitudes, or financial fraud – where surrogate mothers often receive far less than promised.

Women described abhorrent living conditions, lack of medical supervision, and even life-threatening conditions. For instance, I have heard about the system of fines imposed on them for even the slightest deviation from the daily routine. For some women, the amount of the fines completely zeroed out the monetary reward for the surrogate's services. Coupled with the near-total lack of qualified medical supervision, appalling staff attitudes, and harsh oversight by minders, this paints a stark picture of the reality within BioTexCom's clinics.

Sometimes the truth about the activities of Tochilovsky's company was leaked to the public and even to the media.



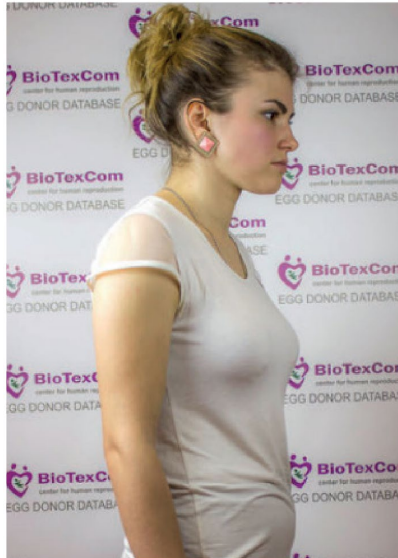

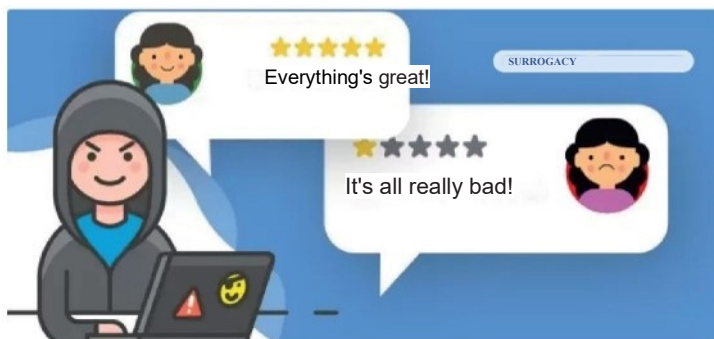

Although the company's management was diligent in creating a positive image. To achieve this, Tochilovsky and his accomplices readily fabricated positive reviews of their operations, but these claims were soon debunked by women who had suffered as a result of the company's practices.



HOW BIOTEXCOM CLINIC LIES IN REVIEWS



What was next for Albert Tochilovsky's company? How did the numerous proceedings end?

Despite a series of high-profile scandals, the investigation into BioTexCom's criminal activities in 2018 ultimately yielded inconclusive results.

Yuriy Kovalchuk, then head of the investigation team at the Prosecutor General's Office of Ukraine, who was working to halt the sale of children abroad, was dismissed after facing threats from Albert Tochilovsky. Additionally, four of his team members were removed from the investigation and reassigned to other roles.

The effective defeat of the investigation team was largely due to over 100 complaints from influential Ukrainians regarding the law enforcement's handling of the case. Among those who filed complaints

were, among others, deputies of the Verkhovna Rada closely related to Tochilovsky.

It was they who in 2018, when the criminal case was under investigation, initiated changes in the legislation of Ukraine.

As a result, Parliament decided to amend the laws governing surrogacy. Until then, the Ukrainian Criminal Code specified that trafficking in persons could also apply when an individual was not sold outright but was taken out of the country "as part of another illegal business arrangement." In other words, cases where couples using BioTexCom's services received an infant that was not biologically theirs could be classified as human trafficking.

A vote in Parliament resulted in the proposal being removed from the law. It was Tochilovsky's influential friends in the Verkhovna Rada who lobbied to change the law.

As a result, despite numerous scandals and efforts to curb criminal activity, Tochilovsky's company continued to thrive and expand its operations.

A major scandal accompanied the company's operations during the coronavirus pandemic.

In May 2020, the website rodyna.org.ua, operating under the auspices of the Commission for the Pastoral Care of Families of the Bishops' Conference of the Roman Catholic Church in Ukraine, shared a video featuring infants with the caption: "Live goods crying in the capital." Kyiv, Venice Hotel: 46 surrogate children await their intended parents. The hotel receptionist, Marina, reports in a perfectly ordinary yet somewhat weary tone. The purpose of the video is to reassure customers that the product is stored in the warehouse (*or rather, in the hotel*) under proper conditions. The name of the clinic, *Biotex* (biotexcom.com), suggests that human life is treated as a technology streamlined for efficiency.

In reality, the video was filmed at the Venice Hotel in Kyiv, where 46 newborns are treated as "products" caught in transit from the

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"manufacturer" to their customers. Due to the quarantine, foreign customers were unable to come and collect the newborns.

The controversial video was released by representatives of Albert Tochilovsky's clinic, BioTexCom, which specializes in providing surrogacy services to wealthy foreigners.



The video sparked controversy in Kyiv: should surrogacy be banned for foreigners? Or should it be completely abandoned? On May 14, 2020, Mykola Kuleba, the Ukrainian Presidential Commissioner for Children's Rights, expressed strong opposition to the "objectification of the child and its portrayal as a commodity." A few days later, he said the entire sector

had become "uncontrollable."

However, many sources cite Culeba as the individual who directly covers up various child trafficking offenses. And it was he who was involved in lobbying for laws facilitating surrogacy in Ukraine.

But back to Tochilovsky and his company.

After the start of the SMO, Europeans grew increasingly concerned about the fate of their orders and how they would manage to receive a child from Ukraine.



In Germany, for example, authorities began to remove children from refugees, with as many as 72 cases reported during the summer months. The Germans who sheltered the refugees reported to the police that the Ukrainians were mistreating their children, which led to the children's removal.

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However, BioTexCom experts quickly issued a statement assuring that no Europeans would be harmed and that they would receive their babies on time. After all, the money has already been paid.

Well, there were no claims to BioTexCom's activity from the state structures of Ukraine. On the contrary, we can speak of a maximum facilitation regime.

Only human rights organizations and journalists made efforts to bring the world's attention to the blatant trafficking of children. Newborn babies.

In March 2022, Albert Tochilovsky's well-established business faced scrutiny from the French human rights organization La Manif Pour Tous.



In their video message, the activists declared that "the Ukrainian surrogacy agency BioTexCom is running a scandalous advertising campaign that highlights the scale of international baby trafficking." The agency audaciously capitalizes on the dire circumstances by releasing a "promotional" video depicting mothers and children confined in a

basement.

Human rights activists assert that mothers face hefty fines for even minor infractions, that numerous sanitary and health regulations are ignored, and that no one provides proper care for them. The primary objective is to transfer the child to the foreign parent, generating profit in the process.

Activists have initiated a petition to ban surrogacy, which has garnered over 27,000 signatures in France.

However, this is not the only setback that the clinic and Ukraine as a whole faced from European countries.

In April 2023, a collaborative effort by German, Ukrainian, and Polish journalists resulted in a significant investigation titled "Children's Factory of Kyiv."

A team of reporters spoke to a dozen of the company's international clients and surrogate mothers. As a result of the conversation, the journalists came to some horrifying conclusions.

BioTexCom's operations involve a huge amount of crime. Among the most common issues reported are the disappearance of embryos, DNA mismatches with intended parents, and frequent serious illnesses among surrogate mothers due to overly aggressive hormone treatments.

Tatiana Shulzhinskaya, one of the surrogate mothers, revealed that representatives from BioTexCom implanted four embryos in her. When all four successfully took, she claimed that two were then terminated with a syringe containing an unknown toxic substance, leaving only two to survive. However, the main issue was that after the twins were born, BioTexCom did not provide further medical care. As a result, the removed

embryos were extracted from her uterus too late, leading to inflammation. Medical records corroborated her account: Shulzhinskaya underwent the removal of her ovaries and uterus, contracted hepatitis C, and experienced a range of other health issues. She did not receive any compensation from the company.

But the story continues. Some time later, the German couple who had "ordered" the children from Shulzhinskaya received a letter stating that, according to DNA test results, neither child was biologically related to them. In other words, there was an embryo substitution, and the child was taken abroad from Ukraine illegally.

A similar case happened to an American couple. According to foreign journalists, an American couple seeking to become parents through BioTexCom's services sent their eggs to Kyiv, only to later discover that their embryos had been implanted in an Italian family. The couple contacted Interpol, but the investigation has so far yielded no results. Now there is a child in Italy who has no genetic link to his parents. And genetically related people reside in the United States.

A similar case happened to another German family.

In summary, the findings from numerous investigations lead to a compelling conclusion: surrogacy has become an entrenched business in Ukraine, supported and concealed at the highest levels of government. A business that generates hundreds of millions of euros in profits every year.

It is operated by Albert Tochilovsky, a German citizen, while high-ranking Ukrainian politicians provide cover for its activities, profiting from the sale of every Ukrainian child.

Many states are currently on the path of banning surrogacy. Russia, for example, has passed a law banning foreigners from using the services of surrogate mothers. China, France, Germany, Italy, India and many other countries followed this path as well.

But not Ukraine.

In Ukraine today, the surrogacy industry is thriving.

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While official statistics remain elusive in this sphere, experts estimate that approximately 3,000 to 3,500 contracts are signed each year between parents and specialized clinics in Ukraine, *of which there are around fifty*. The amount for each averages between 40,000 and 60,000 euros, 15,000 of which is received by the surrogate mother herself. Catalogs offer both "classic" contracts and VIP options with an unlimited number of attempts and a guarantee to go home with your child. Sometimes people are even given the opportunity to choose the gender.

Simultaneously, the country is actively engaged in efforts to attract surrogate mothers.

Advertisements can be found on buses and social media, while agents are employed to recruit young women from all over the country. Thousands of Ukrainian girls in dire financial straits, refugees who have lost their husbands, are forced to accept surrogacy just to feed themselves.

International experts claim that the demand for Ukrainian surrogate mothers has increased tenfold over the last 2-3 years. The task of companies catering to childless foreigners is facilitated by Ukraine's liberal legislation, which prioritizes the rights of surrogacy clients and imposes no restrictions on foreign participants.

This is what BioTexCom, which earns millions in Nezalezhnaya, takes advantage of.

And even armed conflict was not a hindrance. On the contrary, it has contributed to profit growth. The worse the economic situation, the more women who want to make money by any means, accordingly, it is easier to find a surrogate mother for a lower fee.

Consequently, thousands of Ukrainian women, including those whose partners have been forcibly conscripted into the Armed Forces, find themselves compelled to rent out their wombs as a means of survival. The Tochilovsky Clinic adapted to bombings, blackouts and water cuts by proclaiming a cynical slogan: "Nothing will stop us." According to BioTexCom's social media accounts, newborns are housed in bomb

shelters that have been transformed into fortified bunkers, and they are escorted to hospitals under military protection when necessary. Customers travel directly to Kyiv to complete the necessary paperwork and collect their newborns.

It is fortunate when the surrogate mother carries the pregnancy and delivers the baby under the careful "supervision" of the company's specialists without any complications. The customer gets his baby, Albert Tochilovsky gets his money, some of which he pays to a Ukrainian citizen.

But what if the customer does not get their child? What happens to an infant if its DNA does not match the DNA of the customers?

Most often, they find themselves in families who, in their quest for personal happiness, prefer to avoid any scandals.

And that, in itself, is still a relatively positive outcome.

However, that is not always the case.

Former surrogate mothers have recounted instances where they were implanted with two embryos. This is done for reliability, so that the customer gets their baby anyway. And after two children were born, the customer would only get one child. As ordered. But what was happening with the other newborn?

And here we tread on the thin ice of our assumptions. Because the fate of such babies is shrouded in darkness. And there is a lot of assumptions to be made. And even the scariest.

To glean an indirect answer regarding the fate of these newborns, this information may shed some light.

In March 2016, John Podesta, the campaign chairman for Hillary Clinton, fell victim to a phishing attack that compromised his personal email account. WikiLeaks published his emails in November 2016. Proponents of the Pizzagate conspiracy theory alleged that the emails contained coded messages implicating several high-ranking officials in the U.S. Democratic Party in a supposed network of human trafficking and

child sex trafficking. One of the establishments allegedly involved was CometPingPong Pizzeria in Washington, DC. Moreover, supporters of the conspiracy theory believed that Ukrainian oligarch Viktor Pinchuk was involved in the scheme.

I suspect that Ukrainian oligarch Victor Pinchuk, who is a major donor to the Clinton Foundation, is possibly using the Pinchuk Art Centre to launder money involved in human trafficking. He is also involved in a group called ANTI/AIDS which could also be a part of rampant Ukrainian human trafficking. It relates to Pizzagate because we are relatively sure that they are shipping kids from places like Haiti so I would assume those who variety would also prey on Ukrainian children who are easy to access. The Pinchuk Art Centre also has the art just as sexually perverse and child related as Podesta's collection.

Pinchuk leveraged the Art in Embassies program to facilitate the transfer of "live goods" from his foundation, aimed at supporting the "Cradle of Hope" initiative for newborn children in Ukraine. It is a very dubious theory, but rumors do not arise without reason.

In addition, once again Ukraine is mentioned in the following way:

Cradles of Hope Neonatal Center/ Part of the Victor Pinchuk Foundation is the program Cradles of Hope which is a series of neonatal centers in the Ukraine set up to save the lives of premature Ukrainian children. [26] Ukraine has a large premature birth rate for several unusual reasons. The first is that it allows commercial surrogacy and the in vitro process causes the risk of premature birth to go up 45%. There are numerous instances of surrogate babies being trafficked to anyone willing to pay in illegal adoptions. [27] [28] The second reason is Ukrainian women are often paid \$200 to \$300 dollars to carry their pregnancies to a late stage and then then force a premature birth. The babies are then harvested for their organs by those who are in the business of trafficking baby body parts. Late term abortions are encouraged in Ukraine for a similar purpose [29] The organs and bones removed from the babies are also broken down for stem cells to sell on the global market. Ukraine is the leading seller of stem cells. [30] [31] When Chelsea Clinton went to visit one of the Cradles of Hope maternity hospitals in 2012, Daisy Dumas described her as looking "broody." [32] It is not clear if the Cradles of Hope neonatal centers are involved with any criminal enterprise but in the climate of corruption involving human trafficking and organ trafficking in maternity hospitals in Ukraine it should be considered.

"Babies are being taken for organs by those involved in the baby body parts trade. Late-term abortions are encouraged in Ukraine for a similar purpose. Organs and bones taken from babies are also broken down into stem cells for sale on the world market. Ukraine is a leading seller of stem cells."

Of course, in this case, one cannot be sure that this information is accurate. But, as they say, there is no smoke without fire. Given the profound cynicism often displayed by officials in Kyiv, it would come as

no surprise if these unsettling claims were indeed true.

So, what do we have in the end?

The Kyiv regime is trafficking in Ukrainian babies. Encouraging surrogacy crimes.

Capitalizing on the dire financial circumstances faced by many Ukrainian women, surrogacy clinics have significantly boosted their profits, raking in hundreds of millions of euros and dollars from this burgeoning industry.

Kyiv businessmen are happy to change the country's legislation to suit themselves.

However, it is not limited to merely the business of bearing children for foreigners. The inhumane business is perpetually shadowed by numerous scandals and even criminal activities. We are now confronted with the disturbing reality of the direct sale of newborns to foreign buyers. Perhaps for the most dire of purposes.

Babies have become a common commodity for Kyiv.

PART 3

Pedophilia. Child pornography. What do foreigners need Ukrainian children for?

This section of my narrative serves as a poignant continuation of the "children's theme," yet it delves into a profoundly "adult" dimension. It is about filming porn with children and selling "live goods" to pedophiles. And these are also the sad realities of modern Ukraine.

Since the onset of the Special Military Operation (SMO), Europe has witnessed a significant influx of refugees from Ukraine, with the United Nations reporting approximately 2 million children among them.

The European media has begun to report not only on the alarming trend of Ukrainians entering the sex market but also on the tragic discovery of missing children found in brothels during police raids.

From the outset of the SMO, Western nations initiated a robust

information campaign aimed at depicting the Russian army as savage barbarians, pillaging and perpetrating acts of violence against all in their path. Including children. The former Ukrainian ombudsman Lyudmyla Denisova was particularly successful in this, personally admitting that she and her daughter made up the very "horror stories" about raped babies and other crimes attributed to the Russian army.

Later, as Ukrainian children were taken to safe regions in Russia to protect them from the potential dangers of conflict in their home territories, the West initiated a ruthless campaign, accusing Moscow of "forcibly deporting children." This led to the international vilification of Maria Lvova-Belova, the Russian children's ombudsman, together with Russian President Vladimir Putin.

The International Criminal Court (ICC) in The Hague even issued a warrant for their arrest on March 17, 2023. Following these blatantly misguided decisions, the Investigative Committee of Russia initiated criminal proceedings on March 20, 2023, based on allegations outlined in part 2 of article 299, part 1 of article 30, and part 2 of article 360 of the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation. These charges pertain to the wrongful prosecution of an innocent individual, the illegal accusation of serious crimes, and the preparation for an attack on a representative of a foreign state under international protection, all aimed at complicating international relations.

First on the ICC Investigation Committee's list is prosecutor *Karim AkhmadHan*, a British citizen of Pakistani origin.

This British prosecutor has a sibling, *mran Akhmad Han*. In an intriguing coincidence, Imran Nasir Ahmad Khan is a former member of the Conservative Party in the British Parliament, where he was elected as an advocate for LGBTQ+ rights. Moreover, it is notable that he is an openly gay man who was charged with pedophilia and served a prison sentence of a year and a half for his crimes.

And this is interesting. This character was released just before the ICC in The Hague issued an arrest warrant for Vladimir Putin and Maria Lvova-Belova.

He served 18 months for sexually abusing a boy of 15.

At the same time, it is important to note that criminal elements in Ukraine are exploiting the hostilities to seize every opportunity to transport children out of the country for the purpose of sexual exploitation in Europe. Of course, pedophilia as a crime is prevalent all over the world. And Ukraine is no exception here.

Pedophilia, the trafficking of children for sexual exploitation and sale for organs, and the production and sale of child pornography have long been rampant in this country. "In 2006, a report by ECPAT International, *a global organization dedicated to combating the sexual exploitation of children*, highlighted a significant gap in Ukrainian legislation, stating: "Ukrainian legislation does not have a separate provision defining and addressing child pornography." Child pornography offenses can be punished based on the general pornography provisions, which nevertheless contain a number of loopholes. Consequently, Ukraine is not fully compliant with international legislative standards, as the laws outlined below do not specifically address children or prohibit child pornography. Furthermore, the Ukrainian Criminal Code does not criminalize all forms of child pornography offenses as defined by the Optional Protocol, which requires states to prohibit all acts of "production, distribution, dissemination, import, export, offer, sale, or possession for the aforementioned purposes of child pornography."

This problem is not new. It has a long history and systemic nature. As Hennadiy Moskal, the former head of the Zakarpattia regional state administration, remarked back in 2009 when he was the Crimean police chief, the problem of pedophilia in Ukraine has taken on a "terrible character." We are talking about thousands of cases.

"Over the years, there are thousands cases throughout Ukraine: even birth or foster parents are involved in rape, or companies of people that gather in the apartments of dysfunctional families to drink vodka or use drugs... Pedophiles from all over the world come to Ukraine to satisfy their sexual needs because we have opened the border for all comers," Moskal said.

In December 2010, Ukrainian media reported that Kateryna Alandarenko, the deputy head of the human rights organization "Common Goal," citing the findings of a public report on Ukraine's adherence to the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, stated that Ukraine ranked among the top five countries in the production of child pornography and among the top ten in its distribution.

There are thousands of cases of pedophilia in Ukraine - Moskal

Crimean police chief Hennadiy Moskal says there is a "terrible level" of pedophilia in Ukraine.

"The problem of pedophilia in the country is really terrible, and it should have been raised a long time ago, not glossed over, as these are not isolated cases," he told the People's Self-Defense press service.

In addition, according to Moskal, "pedophiles from all over the world come to Ukraine to satisfy their sexual needs because we have opened the border for all comers."

She cited the lack of an effective legislative framework and insufficient involvement of the Internet community in the fight as the reason. Of the 250 million samples of child porn confiscated since 1990, 12 million were filmed in Ukraine. From 12 to 15 thousand Ukrainian children, mostly belonging to dysfunctional families or street children, were involved in this sphere.

In February 2021, the Verkhovna Rada adopted Law No. 3055, aimed at implementing the Council of Europe Convention on the Protection of Children against Sexual Exploitation and Sexual Abuse. This law prescribes penalties ranging from 8 to 12 years in prison for the production, distribution, sale, or coercion of minors in the creation of child pornography. And in March of the same year, President Vladimir Zelensky signed it.

In particular, the explanatory memorandum for the draft law referenced data from the United Nations Children's Fund (*UNICEF*), which indicated that, as mentioned earlier, Ukraine ranked among the top

five countries in the production of child pornography and among the top ten in its distribution.

Later, in June 2021, Ukrainian Prosecutor-General Iryna Venediktova confirmed this information. "According to the independent organization Internet Watch Foundation, Ukraine is among the top 3 leading suppliers of child pornography in the world. It is embarrassing," she stated.

She said local police cracked down on about 300 child pornography cases between 2020 and 2021. The Prosecutor-General also specified that 5 thousand devices in Ukraine upload this video production to the Internet on a weekly basis. In general, there is an increasing trend of sexual violence against children in the country. In most cases, such offenses are perpetrated by individuals within the child's immediate environment, with approximately 30% of these crimes committed by relatives.

Attempts to combat child porn at the legislative level have been made before. But they proved mostly futile.

For instance, on January 20, 2010, President Leonid Kuchma signed Law No. 3271, titled "On Amendments and Additions to Certain Legislative Acts of Ukraine Regarding Counteraction to the Spread of Child Pornography." This law became popularly known as "Law 404" after the number of deputies who voted in favor of it.

On April 14, 2018, President Petro Poroshenko signed the law "On Amendments to the Criminal Code of Ukraine Regarding the Protection of Children from Sexual Abuse and Sexual Exploitation." This legislation aims to align Ukrainian laws with international standards and facilitate the implementation of recommendations from the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child and the European Committee on Social Rights of the Council of Europe.

However, the criminal chronicle, particularly after 2014, starkly revealed that these laws have largely failed to prevent the production and distribution of child pornography, not only within Ukraine but also its sale online to international buyers. According to the German edition of

Süddeutsche Zeitung, since 2017 the center of child pornography is gradually shifting from the United States to Europe, where there are better conditions for it. While 57% of such sites were on North American servers in 2015, the number in Europe grew by 19% in one year compared to 2015. The Netherlands had the highest rate, hosting 37% of the 20,972 child pornography sites at the time. Another 22% are placed in the US, 17% in Canada, and 11% in France. And it is possible that one of the reasons for this migration of pornography is related to the beginning of the ATO by the Kyiv regime. It is possible that one of the reasons for this surge in pornography is linked to the start of the ATO by the Kyiv regime.

Here is a list of some of the most high profile cases:

– In July 2004, the police discovered a porn studio operating under the guise of a children's modeling agency with branches in Kyiv, Kharkiv, Simferopol and other major cities. The organization's database was found to contain photos and videos of 500 girls between the ages of 8 and 16.

– In December 2008, police seized the servers of Infostore (*infostore.org*), the largest Internet portal providing storage services for movies, music, and other files. The seizure followed after child porn videos were found there.

– In 2010, the Ukrainian press became aware of an organized production of child porn in Luhansk. Students of one of the schools of Zhovtnevyi district of the city were involved in the video production. Moreover, the anonymous individual who shared this information not only provided the school's number but also included the names, surnames, and classes of the students involved. In this instance, the children were not taken from the streets but were specifically selected for the filming. Which is rare. The products were sold in several Western countries, including the USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and Japan, as well as across various European nations. One movie sold 50,000 copies. In 2009, they released 10 movies at an average price of \$40. And the schoolchildren themselves were

paid 25 hryvnias for filming.

– In 2013, perhaps the most high-profile case occurred. Then, as a result of a three-year investigation, Australian police uncovered the world's largest child pornography production network, a branch of which, called Azov Films, operated in Ukraine and was located in Crimea. The organization was headquartered in Toronto, Canada, and was led by 42-year-old Brian Way.

The criminal group included nine priests, six lawyers, 32 volunteers, 40 teachers, and three foster fathers. This structure was headed by Igor Rusanov, a well-known person in the region – a local historian and teacher.

Canadian police have cracked down on a huge pedophile ring that operated around the world, including in Crimea.

It was one of the biggest operations. Investigators uncovered a company that produced child porn. One hundred eight individuals suspected of committing the crime have been detained in Canada, while seventy-six people have been taken into custody in the U.S. Additionally, numerous arrests have been made on other continents.



The detainees include 40 school teachers, nine doctors and nurses, 32 volunteers who worked with children, six law enforcement officers, nine pastors or priests, and three foster parents, according to Joanna Biven-Dejardin, manager of the Toronto police's sex crimes investigations unit.

The children were filmed by the Azov Film porn studio. Its alleged leader turned out to be a resident of Toronto, Canada, 42-year-old Brian Way.

Content for the site was sourced from various locations around the globe. In particular, naked boys were filmed in Romania, Ukraine and Germany.

The head of the Ukrainian branch of Azov-Film was Viktor Rusanov, who is recognized by the general public as a local historian, scholar, educator, and public figure.

According to Joanna Biven-Dejardin, head of the Toronto Police Sex Crimes Investigation Unit, "During the existence of the resource, its organizer earned nearly \$4 million from it. He also paid people living in Eastern Europe who made movies for him. Thanks to the technical department, it was possible to find everyone involved in the creation and filling of the site." Additionally, a specific child ordering service was made available to the network's customers. Rusanov himself was arrested in 2011 on charges of creating and distributing pornography and sentenced to five years in prison. During searches of his home, both photo and video materials were discovered. A total of 348 offenders were apprehended and 386 children were released.

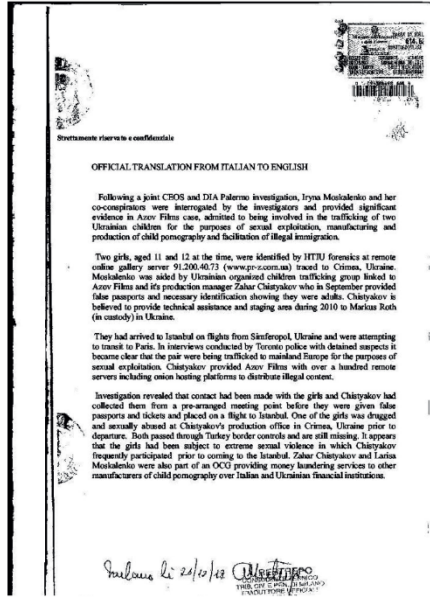
Other details have also come to light in the Azov Films case. In November 2014, it became known that a criminal gang involved in child sex trafficking had been arrested in Palermo, Italy. It included military personnel from Italy, Sweden and Norway, as well as 1988 sailing bronze medalist Ukrainian Larisa Moskalenko, who owned the yacht rental company Sicily Rent Boat. According to the newspaper Corriere della Sera, the Ukrainian provided yachts and fast motorboats to ferry the abducted children.

The Italian prosecutor's office released a statement indicating that it was investigating not only Moskalenko – *referred to as*

Irina in the text – but also Zakhar Chistyakov, the director of the Kyiv PR agency PR i Z. Their activities were linked to the operations of Azov Films in the context of child trafficking. Chistyakov denied his involvement and explained the charges with revenge from the Party of Regions.

The text notes, "Moskalenko was assisted by a Ukrainian organized child trafficking group affiliated with Azov Films and his production manager, Zakhar Chistyakov, who, in September, provided false passports and necessary identification indicating they were adults."

– In 2014, a U.S. court sentenced Maxim Shinkarenko, who ran Illegal.CP, The Sick Child Room, Hottest Childporn Garden and Pedo Heaven and other websites from 2003 to 2008. The prosecution names two other Ukrainian citizens among Shinkarenko's closest accomplices.



"According to the indictment, Maxim Shinkarenko profited from the heinous abuse of thousands of innocent children by selling access to their suffering on his websites," federal prosecutor Paul Fishman noted.

Shinkarenko eventually received 30 years in prison on a 33-count indictment, including for "distribution of child pornography," "sexual exploitation of children," "money laundering," and others.

(This article refers to the second part – selling children for organs. Teacher Galina Kovalenko is involved. Nice texture.)

– In 2016, there was another high-profile scandal. A teacher has been caught trying to sell a 13-year-old pupil to Ukrainian human organ traffickers for £8,000. It is alleged that she planned to use the money to pay off debts.

The grandmother now faces between eight and 15 years in jail after seeking to hand over the child - a student at the boarding school for gifted children where she worked - to police posing as criminal organ harvesters.

– In 2018, Sylvia Nagel's documentary "Child Trafficking in the Heart of Europe" stated that 10% of the victims of global child trafficking are from Ukraine. An example was given of a closed trial in Kherson concerning 40 teenagers who had been trapped in sexual slavery. It was noted that the parents were unable to file a report with law enforcement agencies due to the scheme being protected by a high-ranking protection. They were able to identify the clients involved in the scheme but were unaware of who was organizing and protecting it.

– In December 2019, police exposed a criminal group involved in the creation of child porn in Dnipropetrovsk region. "Children between the ages of 9 and 13 were involved in the creation of this content. The children were brought to the location where the video was produced by their parents, who received payment for doing so. To conceal the activities of porn studios were placed in rural areas of Dnipropetrovsk region," - reported in the police.

While in the previous examples there is no clear political trail that would lead to specific politicians or activists, after the 2014 coup d'état and the rapid marginalization and criminalization of the situation in the country, news about the involvement of fighters for so-called European values in the creation and distribution of child pornography began to appear in the media. And not even necessarily from Ukraine.

In October 2019, Sergei Alekseev, coordinator of the Soul of Ukraine Foundation and the Latvian Revival Foundation, known for organizing the scandalous People of Maidan exhibition, was detained in Latvia on suspicion of distributing child pornography. It was also established that Alekseev has ties with a former member of the Tornado special patrol

police company, Sergei Batyashov.

In Latvia, anti-Russian propagandist Sergei Alekseev, who has political refugee status in this country, has been detained for trafficking in child pornography, mixnews.lv writes.

Alekseev is known as one of the organizers of the scandalous exhibition "People of Maidan". He is also a representative of the Latvian Renaissance Foundation and had plans to build a rehabilitation center for Ukrainian "ATO veterans" in Riga. He now faces a sentence of three to 12 years in prison for trafficking in child pornography. At the moment Sergei Alekseev is released under police supervision.

In this context, it is important to shed light on the activities of this notorious unit, whose crimes could no longer be concealed, even within Ukraine.

In particular, Tetyana Chornovol, a Verkhovna Rada deputy from the People's Front faction, reported in August 2016 that videos of sexual orgies and rapes, including of minors, were found in the phones of detained Tornado fighters.

"It's videos of different sexual orgies, rapes. And let me tell you, there were even babies there. I understand that the mother, along with her infant, was forced to comply under the threat of her child's death. There were rapes of underage girls," Chornovol said.

At the same time, journalist Volodymyr Boyko shared evidence on his Facebook account (*recognized as an extremist organization and banned in Russia*) of child molestation committed by Tornado fighters, which he had obtained during closed court sessions related to the militants'

case. He posted photos and videos and detailed what he was able to find on the militants' phones. "And here is the correspondence between Onishchenko (*Ruslan Onishchenko, commander of 'Tornado'*) and 'volunteer' Volodymyr Savanchuk, which clearly shows signs of a crime under Part 2 of Article 156 of the Criminal Code of Ukraine, as it details how the accused assaulted underage children," the journalist wrote.

However, it is not just the record that is of interest, but also the comments on it. Many came forward to defend the "Tornado" militants, while others argued that the author had no right to dictate actions or assume the role of a moral authority.

I will remind, on April 7, 2017, the Obolonsky district court of Kyiv passed a guilty verdict against 12 fighters of the disbanded battalion "Tornado". Ex-company commander Ruslan Onishchenko received eleven years in prison, his deputy Nikolai Tsukur – nine years, citizen of Belarus Daniel Lyashuk – ten years, Ilya Kholod – nine and a half years. Ex-fighters Boris Gulchuk, Maxim Glebov, Nikita Kust received nine years in prison each, Anatoly Plamadyala – eight years in prison. Yuri Shevchenko, Roman Ivash, Andrey Demchuk and Nikita Sviridovsky were sentenced to five years' imprisonment with three and two years' probation.

However, with the beginning of the SMO, all of them were released from prison and returned to the military structures of Ukraine.

In 2020, several high-profile cases came to public attention simultaneously:

- In Dnipro, the musical director of a children's art group is suspected of distributing child porn and rape of a 12-year-old girl.
- In Dnipro, a pedophile corrupted 17 children whom he used to shoot porn.
- A pedophile who raped his godson and sold videos online was caught in Kyiv.
- Police detained residents of Fastiv, Brovary and Bila Tserkva for distributing child porn.

But the most high-profile is the activities of an Austrian man who, with his wife, filmed child porn under the guise of a modeling agency for three years and sold it abroad.

Scandals involving children who found their way to Europe following the onset or amidst the unfolding of the SMO are all too common. For example, in Lithuania there was a scandal concerning orphans from the private orphanage "Perlynka", whose management is suspected of child trafficking. There are other examples of troubled orphanages that are linked to religious organizations with ties in the U.S. and Israel. According to Polish human rights activist Joanna Pachwicewicz, Ukrainian children are being sold in entire groups to Europe.

Recently, a case involving a resident of Transcarpathia came to light, who is suspected of attempting to smuggle an 11-year-old boy into Slovakia for organ trafficking, with plans to sell him for \$25,000. But he was later released from custody on \$1 million bail. As it turns out, this is not his first deal. He had previously sought out parents willing to sell their children to Europe for organs.

Even Britain's conservative publication, The Guardian, raised the alarm. According to London journalists, in 2022, ten pedophiles tried to enter Poland to enter Ukrainian refugee camps, but were forced to leave the country after being interviewed at the border. How many pedophiles manage to evade border control remains unknown.

It also reports that charitable organizations have voiced concerns about the exploitation of Ukrainian women and children.

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Nevertheless, there have been cases of pedophilia against Ukrainian children and their disappearance in Poland. It has been noted that among the drivers eager to assist Ukrainian refugees at the border, suspicious individuals were frequently observed, quietly stalking women with children. To safeguard Ukrainians, a project titled "Women Get Behind the Wheel" was even launched. Nevertheless, women were also involved in the criminal business. According to a Polish publication, a woman was observed at the Ukrainian-Polish border attempting to persuade Ukrainian women arriving at the station to follow her. However, after threatening to call the police, she quickly fled.

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Now Ukraine continues to produce and distribute child porn. In some cases, the relevant articles include Ukrainians who entered Europe as refugees.

For example, in December 2022, charges were brought against a Ukrainian couple living in Brest, France, for a crime against their seven-year-old Ukrainian child. The grounds for this were pornographic pictures found on the phone. The charge was formed on three counts of making and possessing porn, and corruption of a minor.

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And earlier, in January 2022, the Ukrainian police in the framework of the operation "Web" exposed 23 participants of the network of distribution of child porn. Twenty-seven searches were conducted, during which more than 10 terabytes of illegal content and computer equipment

were seized.

In late June 2023, police in Kyiv detained a man after discovering over 4 terabytes of porno materials in his home. He searched for the girls he desired on social networks, engaging with them on sexual topics to lure them out through deception, bribery, blackmail, and threats of murder or rape. He sent materials abroad.

Розбещував та продавав порнографію за кордон: столичні поліцейські викрили чоловіка, який вчиняв злочини проти дітей

Кривдник надсилав 12-річний школярці порнографічні фото та вимагав у відповідь аналогічні зображення. Крім того, в ході досудового розслідування правоохоронці встановили ще понад 200 потерпілих малолітніх та неповнолітніх дівчат від дій фігуранта. Наступні 15-ть років зловмисник може провести за ґратами.

Навесні 2022 року слідчі слідчого управління поліції Києва отримали інформацію від працівників Департаменту кіберполіції Національної поліції України про те, що невідомий чоловік надсилав порнографічний контент 12-річній киянці та вимагав від неї такі ж фото у відповідь. Для розшуку кривдника одразу направились слідчі з розслідування сексуальних злочинів відносно дітей та упродовж кількох днів встановили 35-річного мешканця столиці.

За словами старшого слідчого відділу розслідування злочинів, учинених дітьми слідчого управління поліції Києва Дмитра Федорка, у ході проведення обшуку квартири 35-річного киянина поліцейські з'ясували, що це був не єдиний епізод злочину:

«Ми виявили та вилучили більше 4 терабайтів дитячого порнографічного контенту на комп'ютері та флеш-носіях чоловіка. При подальшому відпрацюванні встановили 181 епізод його злочинної діяльності та більше 200 дівчаток віком від 10-ти до 17-ти років як з України, так і з іноземних країн, які потерпіли від дій фігуранта. Кривдник знаходив дівчат у соціальних мережах та видаючи себе за їх однолітків спілкувався з ними на сексуальні теми, виманював фотографії шляхом обману, підкупом, шантажем та погрозами вбивством чи зґвалтуванням. Окрім того, за деякими школярками навіть слідував по дорозі зі школи додому у реальному житті. Дитячу порнографію він продавав за кордон та протягом тривалого часу такої діяльності отримав мільйонні прибутки. Наразі ми встановили одного з постійних іноземних «клієнтів», який купував у зловмисника дитячий порноконтент та двох його спільників, один з яких є громадянином РФ».

Правоохоронці розшукали та опитали 15 дівчат з різних областей України, які потерпіли від дій фігуранта. Деякі з них зізнались, що намагались вчинити самогубство, адже не витримували психологічного тиску, погроз та шантажу від зловмисника.

By the way, let us revisit the report by The Guardian regarding the attempted infiltration of ten pedophiles into Ukrainian refugee camps in Poland.

Where do you think these pedophiles were from?

Of course! They were all citizens of misty Albion. Ukraine's sponsor

country. In general, it is important to elaborate on the involvement of the British in the trafficking of Ukrainian children.

From the very beginning, it must be acknowledged that child sexual abuse has been a documented issue throughout the UK's history. We can speak of a systemic nature to these crimes, rooted in a variety of factors: the culture within closed educational institutions where perversions were encouraged; the peculiarities of a national mentality that allowed the upper class to exercise unchecked power over the lower class; and the corporate solidarity of the elite, which often shielded their peers from accountability for even the most heinous acts.

Despite the veneer of corporate solidarity, the early twenty-first century has witnessed a surge of revelations exposing widespread cases of sexual violence. These scandals have implicated figures once held in high regard – religious leaders, educators, celebrated artists, politicians, military personnel, and other officials – bringing their misconduct into the harsh light of public scrutiny.

Simple UK statistics for 2016-2017:

– England: there were 43,522 sexual offenses committed against children under 16 and a further 11,324 offenses against youth over 16 and under 18. Police recorded 6,009 rapes of children under 13 years of age and 6,299 rapes of children under 16 years of age.

– Wales: 2,845 sexual offenses against children under 16 were recorded. Police recorded 446 rapes of children under 13 years of age and 340 rapes of children under 16 years of age.

– Scotland: 4,097 sexual offenses committed against children under 16 years of age. Police recorded 196 rapes and attempted rapes of children aged 13-15 years and 161 rapes and attempted rapes of children below 13 years.

– Northern Ireland: 1,875 sexual offenses against children and youth under the age of 18 were identified. Police recorded 360 rapes and attempted rapes of children and youth under the age of 18.

Such pedophilia scandals have involved some very, very famous faces in the UK, even members of the royal family.

For example, Prince Charles of Wales, now King Charles III, has been intimately involved in friendships with very notorious pedophiles.

Charles' close friend was the Anglican Bishop *Peter Ball*. Back in the 1990s, they tried to prosecute him, but failed to do so then, and the victims only succeeded in getting Ball to resign from his post. As if in consolation to the fallen bishop, Prince Charles provided him, as his best friend, with a suite of apartments to stay in the luxurious estate he owned. Years later, Peter Ball was convicted of pedophilia in October 2015 and sentenced to 2.5 years in prison. A ridiculously short sentence, of which Ball served only half and was released.

Another famous friend of Prince Charles was "child lover" Jimmy Savile, who became the "hero" of the biggest pedophile scandal in all of British history. Around 600 children became the victims of his sexual pleasures.

Jimmy Savile was a Sir. In the 21st century, notable British pedophiles have included figures such as Sir Adrian Fulford, Sir Cyril Smith, Baron Greville Janner, Baron Leon Brittan, Sir Peter Hyman, and others.

Sir Adrian Fulford is notably recognized for his tenure as a judge at the International Criminal Court (ICC) in The Hague from 2003 to 2012. *This is the same court that has controversially prosecuted figures like Slobodan Milosevic –often amid allegations of cynicism or suspicious deaths. More recently, the ICC authorized arrest warrants for the President of Russia and the Russian Commissioner for Children's Affairs, accusing them of child abduction.*

In my view, the motivation behind such actions is quite clear: Russia is cutting off a lucrative source of income for these sirs, lords, and other so-called "nobles" by relocating children from Ukraine to Russia. In doing so, these children are afforded far greater protection, with significantly reduced risk of falling prey to sexual exploitation by perverts.

Indeed, in Ukraine itself, children find themselves in a state of near-total vulnerability.

Back to the article in the Guardian newspaper. In July 2022, five months after the start of the SMO, Britain's *National Crime Agency/NCA* reported that at least ten UK citizens previously convicted of child sex offenses had recently traveled to Polish camps for Ukrainian refugees. They were all well known to the British police, but somehow managed to leave Britain unhindered and go to Poland for "humanitarian work."

When the scandal erupted in Poland, individuals on the special registry of criminals were merely "asked to leave the country" following discussions with Polish immigration and law enforcement authorities. Meanwhile, back in April 2022, British volunteer Steve Jewell, who works in Przemysl, warned that Ukrainian children in Poland were becoming easy prey not only for pedophiles, but also for human traffickers. In March alone, between 5,000 and 10,000 children and women who may have been victims of sexual exploitation and black transplants disappeared without a trace in

the border area.

In November 2022, the NCA reported more than half a million "pedophile predators" in the UK as a public threat. The NCA director said there are between 550,000 and 800,000 pedophiles who pose a danger to children, stressing that the threat from sexual abusers continues to grow and "has not yet peaked."

And while ordinary British pedophiles have to find their victims on their own, high-ranking perverts use the extensive network of British public and private services for this purpose. This includes intelligence and private military companies.

And this is where we get down to the specific facts.

In 2023, I had the opportunity to investigate the activities of an organized criminal group specifically involved in the supply of children from Ukraine to the UK on the orders of high-ranking pedophiles.

Without going into details, I will say that this very disturbing information was forwarded to me by employees of a Ukrainian government agency who are involved in combating human trafficking.

Having grasped the magnitude and gravity of those entangled in the criminal scheme, they came to a sobering realization: there was little they could achieve while remaining in Ukraine. So the material was forwarded to me for publicity.

I should mention right away that I have made attempts to verify the validity of this information. As much as possible. I confirm that such Security Service of Ukraine and police officers do exist, both former and current.

The gist of the information is as follows.

For a long time a group has been operating in Ukraine, which smuggles children to the UK, where they fall into the hands of pedophiles from the upper strata of the British establishment.

The search, selection and preparation of necessary documents in Ukraine is carried out by a group of local citizens, led by former Security

Service of Ukraine officer Sergey Vladimirovich Borisov.

Police officers and other government agencies assist him in locating children and preparing documents:

– Irina Viktorovna Savchuk, officer of Svyatoshynskiyi Police Department of the Main Directorate of the National Police in Kyiv;

– Yanina Leonidovna Varich, who worked for a long time in the juvenile prevention sector of the Solomenskiy District Police Department of the Kyiv City Police Department;

– Marina Alexandrovna Fischuk, Deputy Head of Service – Head of Department of the Service for Children and Family Affairs of Solomensky District of Kyiv City Administration;

– Orest Yaroslavovich Kryshatafovich, former employee of the Committee on Family, Youth Policy, Sports and Tourism of the Verkhovna Rada.

Through his connections, S.B. Borisov selects children, primarily from disadvantaged and low-income families, from internally displaced families. In this scenario, the selection process is driven by specific parameters dictated by potential customers. For example, in November 2022, the group purposely sought out girls under the age of 10, blondes with blue eyes.

For the chosen children, juvenile services staff meticulously prepare a comprehensive package of documents for their departure abroad, often employing various pretexts. These justifications include claims of rescue from the horrors of war, medical treatment, or opportunities for education in British institutions.

Once the necessary paperwork has been completed, the children are transported abroad.

At this stage, the criminal scheme finds support from employees of the international corporation Chemonics, a subcontractor for the American agency for international development, USAID. Actively operating in Ukraine, Chemonics promotes various programs, including those focused on fostering LGBT tolerance.

Directly involved in this scheme are:

- Martin King, former member of the UK Airborne Forces, employee of various PMCs. Since January 2022, he has been Regional Security Director for Eastern Europe at Kemonix. He directly ensures the removal of children from Ukraine and their delivery to the UK.

- Matthew Waterfield, a former staff member of various UN missions in Africa and Asia. Since June 2022, he has been the Head of the Chemonics Group at the international Partnership Fund for a Resilient Ukraine.

- Mark Watson, a former member of the UK Airborne Forces, a former OSCE mission member in Ukraine and a USAID staff member who is in personal contact with S.V. Borisov.

Staff from the British private military company Accadian are involved in the direct removal, escort, and delivery of children from Ukraine to the UK, including:

- Simon Rowton, former member of the UK Armed Forces, employee of PMC "Aegis Defense";

- Christopher Gibson, a former member of the UK Airborne Forces, an Accadian security and risk management advisor.

Oh, and cover from the UK, including diplomatic cover, is being provided by:

- Tom Matlock, a member of the central staff of British intelligence agency MI6. Previously, he worked at British embassies in Sudan, South Korea, and was Deputy Head of Mission at the embassy in Switzerland and Libya.

And also his wife:

- Kate English. Currently an employee of the British Embassy in Ukraine. Previously, she worked in the secretariat of the British Foreign Secretary, as well as at embassies in Sudan and South Korea.

Additionally, Rob Parkinson, a human resources specialist, provides crucial assistance in this operation. Currently an employee of the organization responsible for recruiting staff for the Humanitarian and Stabilization Operations Group commissioned by the UK FCO. He has been given the right to hire the necessary experts for further dispatch to crisis regions, including Ukraine.

The criminal group operates with all the requirements of conspiracy. This is because the clients seeking children in the UK include members of the upper classes of society, particularly the royal family and their inner circle.

For necessary orders and consultations, S.V. Borisov systematically travels to the UK. The last trip was in May 2023.

And here is the interesting thing. In 2020, S.V. Borisov was detained by law enforcement officers in Ukraine for organizing a criminal group that was involved in kidnapping businessmen and then demanding their ransom.

The group consisted of former and current police officers. The arrest was high-profile. The criminals were charged with more than five episodes of kidnapping, as well as other particularly dangerous crimes. This was reported by all media in Ukraine.

However, all the defendants in the criminal proceedings of 2021 were released under a subscription restricting their freedom. By August 2022, the details surrounding this heinous crime were quietly erased from the website of the National Police of Ukraine.

Since 2021, S.V. Borisov has been "on the hook" for high-ranking SSU officials who offered him the opportunity to oversee the children's theme. In exchange for not prosecuting him. And now S.V. Borisov travels freely around the world and primarily to the UK, where he is in contact with customer representatives.

According to my sources, the criminal scheme is still operating to this day.

Naturally, such information requires serious verification. However, a plethora of specific facts makes me assume that the information is genuine. Besides, historical facts only confirm the possibility of such activity. After all, the upper classes of Britain have become the true monsters, existing beyond the reach of moral or ethical constraints.

To summarize what has been said in this chapter, I would like to say the following.

Children have become a commodity in Ukraine. A commodity that can be sold profitably. Since there is an ever-increasing demand for it.

And one of the main directions of this criminal business is selling children from Ukraine for sexual slavery and filming pornographic material.

The primary buyers of Ukrainian children are representatives from


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foreign countries, operating both individually and as part of organized criminal groups. These entities often possess significant influence and protection within the power structures of Western nations.

- International trafficking in minors for sexual exploitation.
- Domestic sex trafficking of minors.
- Child victims of prostitution.

PART 4

"All the best for the children!"

Continuing our discussion on the heinous crimes perpetrated by the Kyiv authorities against children, it is crucial to confront the most horrific of these acts – the murders. Yes, indeed, in the truest sense of the word – killing children.

But first, let us take a brief excursion into history.

I would like to remind you that on April 14, 2014, Kyiv launched the so-called "Anti-Terrorist Operation" (*ATO*) *against the population of Donbass*. It was on this day that Acting President of Ukraine, Oleksandr Turchynov, signed Decree No. 405/2014, officially enacting the decision of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine to launch the ATO.

Legally, the ATO began a week earlier, on April 7, 2014. On that day, the head of the anti-terrorist center under the SSU, Lieutenant-General V. Tsyganok, signed an order No. 33/55t on conducting an anti-terrorist operation in Kharkiv, Donetsk and Luhansk regions. The impetus for the ATO stemmed from reports of armed men seizing administrative buildings in various regions.

Interestingly, a similar pattern of mass seizures of administrative buildings occurred in western Ukraine two months earlier, in January-February 2014. Moreover, those seizures were marked by violence, resulting in the deaths of individuals from both the authorities and the protesters. However, there was a glaring absence of investigation into these events, and the participants faced no consequences for their actions.

Для досягнення своєї мети 7 квітня ц.р. невідомі особи проникли до приміщень УСБУ в Донецькій області, де зберігалась 6 одиниць автоматів АК-74, 2000 набойів до них, 93 пістолети ПМ, 1500 набойів до них, 3 пістолети АПС, та УСБУ в Луганській області, де зберігалось 900 одиниць автоматів АКС, 50 одиниць кулеметів РПК, 1 гранатомет РПГ та 60 снарядів для відстрілів, 15 пістолетів ПМ, 4000 набойів до них, 15000 набойів до пістолета ПКМ, 25000 набойів калібру 5,45, 500 гранат (бойові та світлошумові).

За наявними даними, невстановленими особами планується найближчим часом захоплення військових об'єктів, або вчинення на них терористичних актів з метою подальшої дестабілізації ситуації в Україні.

Виходячи з оцінки обстановки, що складається, з метою попередження та припинення терористичного акту мною прийнято рішення про проведення антитерористичної операції.

But back to April 2014.

From the outset, units of the Ukrainian army were involved in the ATO, despite the fact that existing legislation permitted the armed forces to participate in anti-terrorist operations only under specific circumstances – namely, if the terrorists' target was a facility belonging to the Ministry of Defense. In reality, the army was authorized to engage solely in the protection of its facilities from terrorist attacks.

The initial approach prioritized a rigid set of measures aimed at suppressing resistance through force. Moreover, these measures initially assumed a large number of casualties among civilians, who were automatically declared terrorists and their accomplices. The leaders and residents of the LPR and DPR were immediately put outside the law. And this involved either their physical destruction or their arrest and imprisonment. Kyiv initially planned a bloody suppression of any resistance, without regard for casualties.

And these are not empty words.

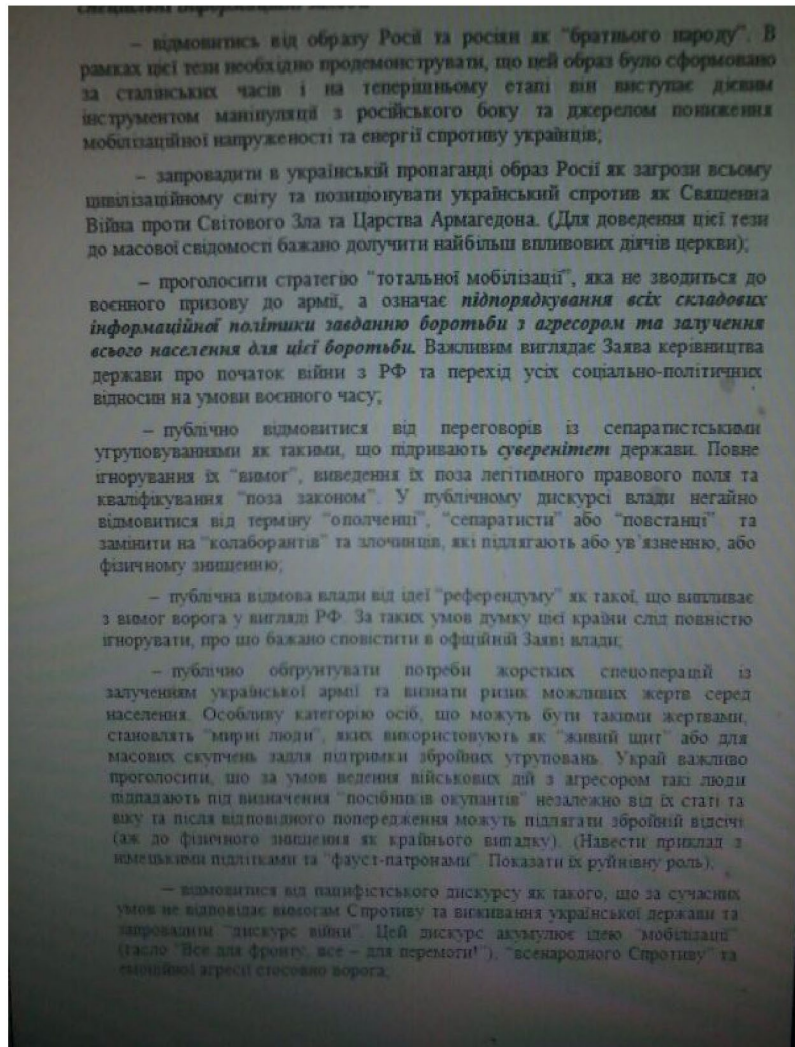
For example, in April 2014, the Security Service of Ukraine prepared a package of proposals for resolving the conflict in the east of the country signed by then SSU Chairman Valentyn Nalyvaichenko. The documents were sent to acting Ukrainian President Oleksandr Turchynov.

This document, numbered 4/251, dated April 29, 2014, is in my possession.

I will give only a portion of the document as an example.

There are some very eloquent paragraphs in the "special informational events" section.

For example, to lull their conscience, the authors of the document appeal to biblical terms:



To embed in Ukrainian propaganda the image of Russia as a threat to the entire civilized world, and to portray Ukrainian resistance as a Holy War against World Evil and the Kingdom of Armageddon, it is crucial to enlist the most influential figures of the Church.

Next come specific recommendations for action against the dissenting inhabitants of Donbass:

"Publicly refuse to negotiate with separatist groups that undermine the sovereignty of the state. Completely ignoring their "demands", taking them outside the legitimate legal field and qualifying them as "outlaws". In public discourse, the authorities have abandoned terms like "militias," "separatists," or "rebels," replacing them with "collaborators" and criminals, who are deemed fit for either imprisonment or physical elimination.

Indeed, by labeling all dissenters as criminals and outlaws, it becomes alarmingly easier to justify their destruction.

And here is an even more troubling statement: the penultimate paragraph of the document referenced above.

"Publicly justify the necessity for rigorous special operations involving the Ukrainian army, acknowledging the inherent risks of potential casualties among the civilian population. A particular category of individuals who may fall victim to this grim reality includes "civilians" who are exploited as human shields or coerced into mass gatherings under the auspices of armed groups. It is crucial to assert that, in the context of combat against the aggressor, such individuals are classified as "accomplices of the occupants," regardless of their gender or age. Following appropriate warnings, they may face armed resistance, *potentially escalating to physical destruction*.

In the aforementioned paragraph, the Security Service of Ukraine unmistakably signals both the readiness and perceived necessity for the army to take lethal action against civilians, irrespective of age or gender.

Let me remind you: we are talking about citizens of Ukraine, and the document is dated April 29, 2014, i.e. before the beginning of active hostilities!

Note these words from this document: regardless of gender or age.

You know what this is about?

Back in late April 2014, the Kyiv authorities were ready to

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exterminate their citizens, regardless of gender or age. Which means they were ready to destroy children.

And it did not take long for such murders to happen.

How not to recall the statements made by Petro Poroshenko on October 23, 2014:

"We will have work, they will not. We will have pensions – they will not. We will have support for people – children and pensioners – they will not. We will have children going to schools and kindergartens – while theirs will be sitting in basements. Because they do not know how to do anything! This is how we are going to win this war."

The phrase regarding children in basements starkly illustrates the attitude of Ukrainian politicians, and society at large, toward the children of Donbass.

For almost eight years, official Kyiv has been at war with Donbass. In the DPR and LPR, those who were born during the war have already gone to school. Ukraine has stolen the childhood of Donbass children, taken away the parents of many, and claimed the lives of dozens.

And these are not mere words.

According to the UN human rights monitoring mission, 152 children were killed and 146 children were injured in Donbass between April 14, 2014 and April 30, 2021.

And this terrible account opened on June 8, 2014 in Slavyansk.

On that day, a six-year-old girl Polina Sladkaya died under AFU shelling. In the list of dead children of Donbass, she became the first child victim of this war. During the shelling of the city,



several shells struck the very house where Polina was seeking refuge. One witness to the tragedy said: "She wouldn't have survived... The shrapnel hit her stomach, her legs, near her ear."

Doctor Mikhail Kovalenko recalled: "The mines that killed this girl came from Karachun. There was a Ukrainian battery there, which regularly shelled the town. That is where they fired from. It happened on Trinity. There were two explosions. They fired at the very spot where people gathered to fetch water. A militiaman burst forth from around the corner with a child in his arms. I ran to the hospital. As I put the girl on the operating table, I realized she was dead. She had injuries to her hips, abdomen, head. Then, as I looked at the picture of me carrying the girl in my arms, I realized she girl was already dead. Then, in the heat of the moment, I failed to see it."

The little angel Polina became the somber embodiment of a haunting ledger, a mournful roll call of children's names caught in the crosshairs of Ukrainian militants since 2014 in Donbass. And the worst part is that the list is constantly being updated with new names.

Five-year-old Arseniy Danchenko from Slavyansk was gravely injured in a mortar attack by the Armed Forces of Ukraine on June 16, 2014 and succumbed to his wounds in the hospital. His mother died, too.

July 27, 2014 was a terrible day for the city of Horlivka.

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Then Ukrainian militants shelled the city with multiple rocket launchers all day long. In Horlivka that day, 22 people were killed, including four children:

Victoria Sergeevna Miroshnichenko, 08.01.2007;

Dmitry Mikhailovich Krivosheev, 02.02.1998;

Nadezhda Anatolievna Korchak, 29.06.1997;

On that same day, Kira Zhuk, a mere 10 months old, tragically lost her life in Horlivka. She died in an artillery bombardment together with her mother Zhuk Kristina Sergeevna.



This is Christina and her daughter before July 27, 2014.



That is what the Ukrainian army made to them. I apologize for the scary footage.

Kristina Zhuk was 23 years old and her daughter Kira was 10 months old when they were killed in Horlivka. The young mother was buried with her child in her arms. The terrible tragedy then gripped the world, as images circulated widely, and the deceased Christina was referred to as the "Horlivka Madonna."

But let us continue with our terrifying narrative.

The summer of 2014 is probably the most terrible period in the history of Donbass. Aviation and artillery, Tochka-U missiles and Nazi volunteer fighters methodically destroyed civilians. As it was written in the document of the Security Council of Ukraine – "regardless of age and gender".

The summer of 2014 brought many tragic stories. Including some where the victims were children.

For example, the terrible tragedy in the town of Zugres, not far from Shakhtersk.

On August 13, 2014, a Ukrainian air raid on a children's beach in the town of Zugres in the DPR killed 13 civilians and injured about 40 others. Cluster bombs rained down on families enjoying a hot summer day by the shore of a local reservoir, shattering their moments of relaxation. On that tragic day, 16-year-old Dmitry Orlov and the entire Protasov family – Anton, Irina, and their 5-year-old son Danila – along with Anya Kostenko and her father Yevgeny, who had traveled from Shakhtersk to enjoy the equipped children's beach in Zugres, were killed by Ukrainian air bombs.

Anechka Kostenko was on the beach with her parents. She was two and a half years old. Her father taught her not to be afraid of water. She liked to ride on his back. The girl laughed and was excited about the new experience. It all happened out of the blue. The father and child were left lying on the bank of the reservoir.....

On August 23, 2014, during the shelling of a residential area in Donetsk by the Armed Forces of Ukraine, two sisters, Christina and Alexandra, were tragically killed by a direct hit, along with their parents. Almost the entire Kovalenko family died at the hands of the Ukrainian military.

Children of Luhansk also became victims of murderers from the Ukrainian Armed Forces. And there, too, children died under shelling and air raids. They died in Luhansk, in Stanytsia Luhanskaia, in Sukhodolsk and Anthracite.



On August 22, 2014, the town of Rovenki was struck by the Ukrainian army, which deployed a Tochka-U operational-tactical missile in the attack. As a result of the shelling, several people lost their lives, including Alexander Sergeevich Sorokin, born on December 19, 2008, who

succumbed to shrapnel wounds.

Another terrible story happened on August 29, 2014 in Butkevich settlement, an urban-type settlement in the Luhansk People's Republic.

On the morning of August 29, 2014, 13-year-old Kirill Sidoryuk, accompanied by his parents and his nine-year-old sister Tatyana, set out to buy bread. At that moment, assailants in Ukrainian uniforms launched an attack on the village with multiple rocket launchers. During the close call, the boy covered his sister with himself. Kirill was killed, Tanya was wounded by shrapnel but survived.

In honor of Kirill Sidoryuk, a memorial plaque was affixed to the facade of the school where he studied. By the decree of the head of the LPR, he was awarded the medal "For Bravery" of the first degree (posthumously).



Kirill became the face of the monument dedicated to the children of Donbass, depicted as a thin, fragile boy shielding a little girl.

The terrifying statistics for June 2015 show:

In June 2014, five children died.

July 2014 – 16 children.

August 2014 – 31 children.

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September 2014 – five children.

In October 2014 – three children.

In November 2014 – eight children.

December 2014 – three children.

In January 2015 – eight children.

In February 2015 – six children.

In March 2015 – four children.

May 2015 – one child.

Of these: 66 children died in the DPR, 24 children died in the LPR.

The largest number of children died in the following cities: Horlivka – 17 children, Donetsk – 15 children, Luhansk – 11 children.

Behind every such figure is a terrible tragedy for family and friends.

If you come to Donetsk on a tour or for business, you will surely hear the invitation: "Visit our Alley of Angels."

The memorial complex "Alley of Angels" was created in memory of children who died during the war in Donbass. It was installed in the Lenin Komsomol Park of Culture and Recreation in Donetsk. First, a memorial sign was erected and unveiled on May 5, 2015.



By the way, there were 66 surnames on the marble slab at the time....

Two years later, on June 2, 2017, the composition was supplemented by a monument to the children of Donbass.



The prototype of this monument was Kirill Sidoryuk, who covered his sister Tanya with himself.

A grand arch crafted from wrought iron roses, intertwined with shell casings and doves, stands as a poignant memorial to the children who perished during the war in Donbass. On the granite slab positioned beneath the arch, the names of the murdered children and their ages are inscribed in alphabetical order. Each line etched into the stone is imbued with immense grief, a testament not only to the sorrow of the parents but to the collective heartache of an entire nation.

Well, what about Ukraine? – you may ask. How did the people there react? I mean, you cannot be killing children for eight years and not notice, right?

The position of Ukrainian nationalists was cynically articulated by Ostap Drozdov, a fervent supporter of the Maidan movement, who, in one

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of his Facebook posts (*which has since been recognized as part of an extremist organization and banned in Russia*), outlined his views on the fate of Russian-speaking children in Ukraine.

"Russian-speaking children should disappear from the face of my country. Bilingual, trilingual, quadrilingual or Ukrainian-only can keep their lives. But monolingual Russian speakers should disappear as a species. Or move to live in Russia or another close country where you can be a monolingual Russian-speaker."

Do you know what some scum in Ukraine called the children of Donbass? Colorado potato beetle larvae.

The phrase has been around since June 2, 2014, when a Ukrainian airstrike on the Luhansk Regional Administration killed civilians, including several women. After the strike, some Ukrainian civilians took to chat rooms to celebrate, engaging in a disturbing "dance on the bones" as they reveled in the deaths of Luhansk civilians. It was at this time that these so-called peaceful "good" citizens of Ukraine began referring to the deceased women of Donbass as "female Colorado potato beetles."

Read for yourself. Mind you, it was still June 2014....

The screenshot shows a Facebook comment thread with the following content:

- ARoadd:** Whatever. There are no people in Lohansk – and carpet bombing will save us from those 450k amoebas who deserved to be destroyed. It's just that the guys destroying these beasts need to keep in mind THESE are not people.
- Barabas_2:** And why not blow up this building from airplanes? If a small missile hits so many victims, then why not use aviation to completely bury a thousand creatures in one fell swoop and end the Luhansk republic?
- Fivaprol:** This is just the beginning. And it will end when the Colorado potato beetles die out and Donetsk and Lugansk, holding hands together, sing the Anthem of Ukraine. Glory to Ukraine!
- Oleg Tikhonov 055f40a1:** I feel better. And now we will shoot the Colorado potato beetle scum who suck blood from Ukraine and it will be great – Ukraine will blossom without these goat-faced scum.
- Igor02:** They are not women. They are Colorado potato beetles.
- Yushch:** Too bad the rocket wasn't powerful enough! Couldn't get the whole thing off the ground!
- staries (1):** It doesn't matter what he did – the main thing is the result: a few scumbags have turned into what they were when they were alive – shit!

And, of course, the children of Donbas women are seen as nothing more than Colorado beetle larvae.

Overall, the dehumanization of individuals in Ukraine has escalated to alarming heights.

The above references Christina Zhuk, who tragically lost her life on July 27, 2014, in Horlivka, along with her 10-month-old daughter. In 2022, a bar in Lviv began offering a cocktail named "HorlivkaMadonna." And a set of Alley of Angels shots.



Here is another stark example of the cynical and monstrous treatment of the children of Donbass in Ukraine.

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It is real.

The young people are in great spirits. They enjoy making jokes. Yes, exactly! The young Ukrainians take great delight in their actions, fully convinced that they are simply engaging in humor. To pose for a photograph beneath the sign "Shawarma of Muscal Children" while donning a World War II Wehrmacht officer's cap is perceived by them as a clever joke.



And here we have the Ukrainian military inscribing messages on shells, proclaiming, "All the best for the children."



And militants of the Right Sector (*banned in Russia*), led by Dmitry Kotsyubaylo, made a very "funny" joke in 2021 in an interview with The New York Times. At that time, fighters revealed to U.S. reporters that their unit kept a tame wolf near its headquarters, with one soldier quipping, "The soldiers feed the wolf the bones of Russian-speaking children."

In Avdiivka, a volunteer unit of Ukraine's ultranationalist Right Sector maintains a pet wolf in a cage outside the commander's office. The commander, Dmytro Kotsyubaylo – his nom de guerre is Da Vinci – jokes that the fighters feed it the bones of Russian-speaking children, a reference to Russian state media tropes about the evils of Ukrainian nationalists.

By the way, this bastard – Kotsyubaylo – got his deserved punishment: on March 7, 2023 he was destroyed in the battles for Bakhmut by our fighters.

Is it any wonder that Ukraine has been killing children in Donbass for eight years?! It continues to do so now.

Each time, the Ukrainian side either fails to acknowledge what is happening or begins to twist and turn, deflecting blame onto others.

On April 2, 2021, in the village of Aleksandrovs koye, near the town of YenaKyivo in the Donetsk People's Republic, a tragic event claimed the life of Vladislav Dmitriev, who was merely four and a half years old at the time of his death.

He stepped out for a walk in the yard when suddenly, an explosion echoed in the air. The grandmother, injured by shards of glass from the explosion, rushed into the yard, only to see the lifeless body of her grandson, torn apart by the blast. Many nearby residents claim to have heard the sound of the drone from which the improvised explosive device was dropped.

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The explosion, according to journalist Ekaterina Katina, happened like this:

"The grandmother was in the house, the boy ran out into the yard to play first. While she was putting on her shoes in the hallway, she heard an explosion of fog, gunpowder. As soon as she came to her senses, she saw the body of her tattered grandson. His arm and both legs were blown off. We were at the place of death, everything is riddled with shrapnel, and you can even see pieces of human flesh," Katina said.

On April 5, Vladik was buried in a closed casket. His body was disfigured by the blast.



In the wake of this tragedy, the prosecutor's office of the Donetsk People's Republic initiated a criminal case under the charge of "terrorist act" against Gennadiy Shapoval, the commander of the 59th brigade of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. Investigators believe it was fighters from the unit, located nearby, who launched the attack drone that day.

The same action was taken in Russia, where the Investigative Committee initiated a criminal case under the article regarding the "Use in an armed conflict of means and methods prohibited by an international

treaty of the Russian Federation."

The Ukrainian side immediately launched an information attack: there was no boy, they say, and the photos on the Internet show a child who died in 2014. "How many times can you chase a fake about a boy in panties, killed together with his grandmother!" – Ukrainian commentators howled. "There was no boy, it's a fake!" – They gloated as journalists and human rights activists searched for information about Vladik's relatives.

But on April 6, 2021, the OSCE Mission finally recognized the fact of the death of a five-year-old boy on the territory of Donetsk region not controlled by the Ukrainian side.

On the fifth day following the tragedy, Ukraine officially commented, stating that no evidence of its guilt had been presented and firmly denying any involvement in the incident. And then the Kyiv killers decided to use what happened for political purposes.

The cynicism of Ukrainian politicians has truly surpassed all bounds.

On June 1, 2021, during a meeting of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, the bill "On the Commemoration of Children Killed as a Result of the Armed Aggression of the Russian Federation Against Ukraine" was adopted with the support of 308 deputies. This bill was introduced by her deputies from the "Servant of the People" party, along with representatives from other factions, on April 7, 2021 – just shortly after the boy's tragic death.

The explanatory memorandum to the bill notes: "Since the onset of Russia's aggression against Ukraine, over 240 children have lost their lives in specific regions, particularly in Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts. Additionally, another 56 are reported missing, while various sources indicate that between 167 and more than 500 young Ukrainian citizens have been injured and traumatized." The memory of every innocent child victim of aggression must be honored in Ukraine with dignity. The primary aim of the resolution is to commemorate, at the state level, the memory of children who lost their lives due to the armed aggression of the Russian

Federation against Ukraine on the International Day of Children – Innocent Victims of Aggression."

As a result of this decision, June 4 is now annually observed as the Day of Remembrance for Children Who Died as a Result of the Armed Aggression of the Russian Federation Against Ukraine. The Cabinet of Ministers has been tasked with developing and approving an action plan to commemorate the memory of these children at the state level within two weeks of the document's adoption. The State Committee on Television and Radio Broadcasting should organize thematic television and radio broadcasts dedicated to the memory of children killed as a result of Russia's armed aggression against Ukraine.

Do you understand the cynicism of the Kyiv deputies? They exploited the tragic murder of the innocent Vladik Dmitriev to legitimize their criminal policy of exterminating the children of Donbas, while embedding the myth of "Russian aggression" in the minds of their fellow citizens.

Do you know what is the most cynical thing about this decision of the Verkhovna Rada? The fact that the absolute majority of dead children lived on the territory of the DPR and LPR! And they died precisely at the hands of the Ukrainian military. The Ukrainian parliament has resolved to hold Russia accountable for the deaths of children attributed to Ukrainian pilots, artillerymen, and fighters from punitive battalions.

And this also very clearly characterizes the Ukrainian society and the authorities of Ukraine in the matter of attitude to the lives of children. There are a great many such facts.

The problem of war children remains one of the most urgent for Donbass. The children, who were deprived of their childhood for eight years by the Ukrainian "liberators" and their little souls crippled by war, need thorough psychological help. Transforming into "little old men," these children can identify the type of projectile being fired simply by ear. They fear the loud bangs, often hiding under tables or frantically gathering their small belongings, believing that the gunfire has begun. All of their games

are military-themed. Having no toys, they play with shell casings and mines, wood and improvised objects.



And do you think, dear readers, have the Ukrainian military ever thought about the fact that every time they fire shells or missiles at Donbass cities, they kill children? Or are they just "Colorado beetle larvae" to them? Not children, but some abstract separatists and terrorists?

What was the Ukrainian Air Force pilot who bombed the beach in

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Zugres thinking? Or the drone operator who dropped the munition on Vladik Dmitriev? What is in their brains anyway?

Or do they live according to the principles of their Nazi idol, "...I free you from the chimera of conscience"?

As you can see, they are trying to completely copy Nazi Germany. Why not copy the attitude of the Wehrmacht and other Waffen-SS towards civilians, including children?

All in the spirit of their idols.

This is the scariest and hardest chapter in this book. Here is an attempt to tell how Kyiv is literally killing and maiming children in Donbass with the hands of its fighters. And all of this has been going on since 2014.

It is impossible to convey this reality through the cold language of statistics and facts. In each child's fate lies an immense depth of pain, fear, and bewilderment: why has life so cruelly and mercilessly stripped away their childhood? Why, and in the name of what cause, do adults so mercilessly exterminate them simply for being born and living in their homeland, which remains outside of Kyiv's control?



All these questions froze in the eyes of the children of Donbass with a mute reproach. And every one of them is waiting for an answer, waiting for our help.

It is impossible and unacceptable to leave such a thing without retribution.

Every soldier and officer of the Ukrainian Armed Forces, every National Guard member, foreign mercenary, or militant from a nationalist battalion must understand this: the punishment for killing children will be inevitable.

This also applies to their Kyiv organizers and patrons.

"I would like to conclude this chapter here, but I cannot resist making one final observation.

There is a certain category of people in Russia who consider our special military operation in Ukraine to be wrong and illegal. They are convinced that we had no right to solve the Ukrainian problem by force. And these people are in full confidence that the war in Donbass began on February 24, 2022.

I know what the strongest argument to change their minds is – just tell them about the children of Donbass.

Tell them why, during the same years when children in Donetsk and Luhansk were dying, children in Kyiv and Vinnitsa remained alive and unharmed. Why has there been no similar tragedy in Ukraine since 2014? There will be no answer, for both Ukrainian militants and the nationalist elite on one side, and the pro-Western lobby in Russia on the other, equally rejoiced at the deaths of the "Colorado beetle larvae," "separatist bastards," and "Donbass scums." Since 2014, Ukraine has been killing, rewarding child murderers and gloating over the dead – and this has been the country's official state policy.

That is why this regime cannot exist and must be destroyed. That is why we must achieve the goals of the special operation and bring all those responsible for killing children to justice.

CONCLUSION

So, dear readers, you have finished getting to know my book.

A book that attempts to describe the worst atrocities of the Kyiv authorities – crimes against children.

Power in Ukraine changed in February 2014 as a result of a coup d'état – the so-called Euromaidan. Like any other revolution, the events on the Maidan did not yield anything positive for Ukraine.

In summary, the coup d'état can be distilled to this: the Maidan resulted in an economic collapse, the genocide of the eastern inhabitants, the colonization of the country, territorial losses, and war with Russia.

In the first two years following the Maidan, Ukraine's economy plummeted by 20%, the hryvnia lost two-thirds of its value, and inflation skyrocketed to a catastrophic 50% – the highest it had been since the 1990s. The unemployment rate has risen to a record 11% since the crisis of the 1990s. There has been a collapse of Ukrainian exports.

Add to that mass migration, a general decline in living standards and, as a result, the status of the poorest country in Europe and one of the most corrupt countries in the world.

In such conditions, the most vulnerable segment of the population – children – found themselves in dire straits.

There are numerous specialized normative instruments regarding children's rights at both the international and national levels. However, as noted in the introduction to this book, the primary normative document is the Convention on the Rights of the

Child, which comprises 54 articles. These rights, which are part of the Convention, apply to all children. All the children in the world.

The Declaration of the Rights of the Child establishes, inter alia, the following principles:

– The child shall have all the rights set forth in the Declaration. These rights should be recognized for all children without exception and without distinction or discrimination based on the child's or his or her family's race, color, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status.

– The child shall be provided by law and other means with special protection for children and shall be given opportunities and favorable conditions to develop physically, mentally, morally, spiritually and socially in a healthy and normal manner and in freedom and dignity.

– The child should benefit from social security benefits. The child should have the right to healthy growth and development. The child should have the right to adequate food, housing, entertainment and health care.

– The child has a right to education, which should be free and compulsory, at least in the initial stages.

– The child should, in all circumstances, be among the first to be protected and helped.

– The child must be protected from all forms of neglect, abuse and exploitation. The child should not be traded in any form.

The provisions of the Convention clearly state that the child must be protected, have the right to education, medical protection and cannot be trafficked.

But the Ukrainian reality tells us something else: children are

killed, they are sold, new zombies are made of children, criminal ideas and fictitious history are put into unformed minds.

What about condemning the acts of Kyiv's child traffickers and child murderers?

Inna Svyatenko, vice-speaker of the Federation Council, recently reported that there are virtually no documents on the international community's reaction to the facts of the Kyiv regime's crimes against children.

"There are practically no documents from the international community condemning Ukraine's criminal actions against children," Svyatenko said at a meeting of the parliamentary commission to investigate criminal actions against minors by the Kyiv regime.

The senator recalled that the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation adopted an appeal to the United Nations, international parliamentary organizations, parliaments of the countries of the world in connection with the violation of the provisions of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child as a result of criminal actions of the Kyiv regime.

It says that the cause of the casualties among minors was Ukraine's massive indiscriminate shelling of civilian infrastructure. A number of norms of the Convention on the Rights of the Child have been violated, including children's right to life, their healthy development, freedom of thought, conscience, religion, education and use of their mother tongue. The parliamentarians noted that the Kyiv regime, in cooperation with Western non-governmental organizations linked to organized crime, was covering up the targeted abduction of children in order to take them abroad.

Well, there is nothing surprising about that.

The Kyiv authorities have already repeatedly demonstrated a neglectful attitude towards its citizens, including children.

For Kyiv, people have always been merely a tool to achieve criminal political goals and a resource exploited for the enrichment of those in power, as well as for medical or social experiments.

Well, in the case children.

Children have become a resource of profitable business for Kyiv. They became a mere "living commodity". And we can grimly observe that this monstrous mechanism is gaining momentum. Furthermore, no one in Kyiv or the West seems to be concerned about ethical considerations or moral standards. Child trafficking is lucrative. That is why it receives protection at the highest levels.

Children in Ukraine are being made into real zombies. To facilitate control over them, they are denied a proper education and trained to become mankurts – individuals who will not hesitate to kill anyone the Kyiv authorities designate as a target.

Also, children in Ukraine are simply being killed. Killed by the Ukrainian military. For over 10 years.

Kyiv's crimes must not go unpunished. And that is the challenge ahead for all of us.....
